Fort Gaines Cemetery Site (New Park Cemetery)

Apparently development in the surrounding area has disturbed or destroyed the village area and the mound remains as an isolated remnant. Several years ago, Frank Schnell, archeologist for the Columbus Museum of Arts and Crafts, tested a Confederate gun emplacement on a hill about 150 yards north of the cemetery. The two hills are about the same elevation. In the slot trenches dug in the Civil War site, he found early Mississippi pottery typical of that found from Moundville, Alabama, to Fort Walton, Florida. This pottery probably came from that general area. Locally, this type pottery was called Rood's Phase.

Just over a mile north, there are portions of five sites of the same time period. These sites are south of the Walter F. George Dam and several similar sites, north of the dam, are flooded now.

A highway and a bridge have been constructed between the hills with the gun emplacement and the cemetery.

The mound has not been excavated, so it is not possible to know how it was used. While its contour is rounded now, this may be the result of erosion or cultivation.
