Statement of Significance (in one paragraph)

The Sioux Falls Fire Station #3 building is being nominated for its significance as an important center for community activity.

Constructed around 1931 for \$22,187.00, the building was first used by the National Youth Administration. It was then taken over by the city of Sioux Falls in 1945 for use as a fire station which served the south side of the city with a four-man engine company. The fire house was also a center for first aid classes, neighborhood socials, open houses, community displays and precinct voting. In 1964, the building was sold and converted into a coffee house for the First Baptist Church. The Bernice Johnson School of Modeling presently (1983) occupies the old fire house.

Describe the present and original (if known) physical appearance

Description

The one-story red brick fire station, located at the northwest corner of Minnesota and 22nd Street, is rectangular in shape with a central bell tower and a side (west) chimney rising above the clay tile barrel roof.

Wood brackets support the overhanging eaves of the roof. A canvas canopy supported by thin metal poles extends from the front (north) entrance to the street. Flanking the entrance are rectangular windows with 8 over 8 sash. Fire trucks originally entered through one of two garages on 22nd street, which are now enclosed with multi-sashed windows, and exited from the rear. There is a small, modern addition with a shed roof located to the rear of the building as well as wooden stairs leading from the back entrance.

The interior has three levels: the lower level was the fire truck garage; the first level was used for administration and operations; and the upper level was used by the firemen for sleeping quarters, etc. Although most of the interior has been revamped in recent years, there are still a few remaining features including some woodwork and the general layout of the building.
