The nominated property consists of a 116 feet long by 25 feet wide rectangle whose vertices coincide with the outside corners of the bridge's piers, and includes only superstructure and substructure.

The bridge in South Beaver Township is an unusually configured, pinconnected Pratt pony truss. Viewed from the roadway, this truss appears to be a typical Pratt pony However, the single truss truss. is supported by a pier in the center, and appears to function as continuous, two-span bridge. а pony trusses are "simply Most supported" spans, i.e., only each end of a single truss rests on a Thus, this bridge is support. typical in truss configuration but function unusual in and substructure configuration. Built about 1878 by the West Penn Bridge Company, it is one of seven Pratt pony trusses included in this nomination. The construction dates for these bridges range from 1871 1906 and they are located to throughout the state.
