thou do. on thy own Acre. we will take at thy Proposal
it will make no difference whether thou draw
through the Bank of Geneva or at N. York
as thou propose

— thou may continue to buy good Wheat for
us not minding $\frac{3}{4}$ the Prospects are quite
improving for Wheat in the Spring. but wish
to keep buying a little to keep our Mills going
