

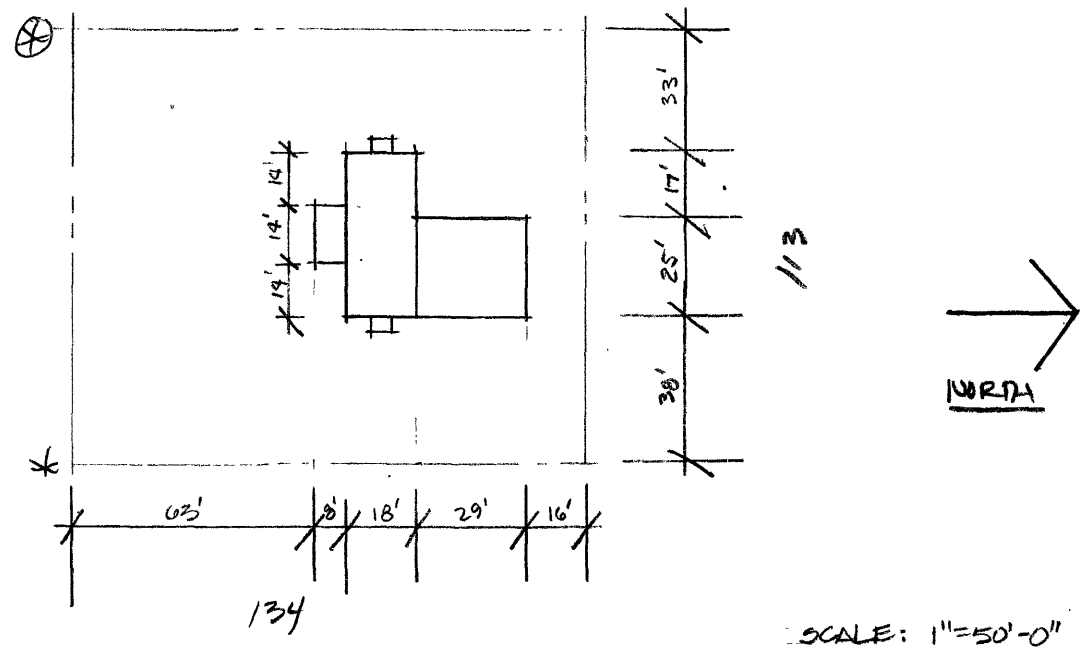

From a point in the North side of Ky 52 then 2000 feet North to the point of beginning; then East 113 feet to a point; then North 134 feet to a point; then West 113 feet to a point; then South 134 feet to the point of beginning.

The point of beginning is 33 feet west and 63 feet south of the southwest corner of the house.
