Exterior:

2-story, 4-bay, brick, centeroverhong passage, single-pile plan, Flemhish bond principal (west) facade, common bond on sides and rear, partially exterior end chimneys, 1-story ? wing removed from south gable end, 1-story, 2-room slightly offset brick ell, no arches over windows, original sash replaced on first floor with 2/2 sash, box cornice, 4-pane sidelights flank 9-panel front door, porch enclosed on north side of ell.

differs from the others in that it is four bays rather than three or five bays in width. It also contains an enclosed corner stair in the south room which opens into that room. This is the only such example noted in the county. The removal of the wing to the south has not compromised the significant form of the structure, nor have other alterations

Interior:

Enclosed stair removed from north side of passage, enclosed stair in northwest corner of south room opens into south room, chair rails, ceiling lowered, federal moldings, mantels contain central tablet with sunburst and reeded pilasters in both north and south rooms, modern kitchen in east room of ell.

Outbuildings:

A non-contributing frame, gable-roofed outbuilding lalong the west fence line. A well of undetermined date is located to the south of the shed. It was not judged to be contributing.

The nominated acreage includes one contributing building, one non-contributing outbuilding and one non-contributing structure.
