18. ROBERT LOUIS STEVENSON BRANCH

803 Spence St.

The Stevenson Branch is an L-shaped building, sited along the rear perimeter of a corner residential lot. The red brick exterior and red tile roof are in stark contrast to the wood frame stucco houses in the neighborhood, visually establishing it as an institutional building in a residential neighborhood. The Spanish style of this one story building is common throughout east Los Angeles.
