Arnold bought later in 1820; owned by David Montgomery 1848 - 1876 and John H. Montgomery 1876-1895; owned by J. B. Montgomery (1/2 interest) 1899-1905; J. T. Montgomery (1/2 interest) 1910-1928; Allen credits Arnold with cutting channel and erecting building, but portions of mill seem to date before his ownership.

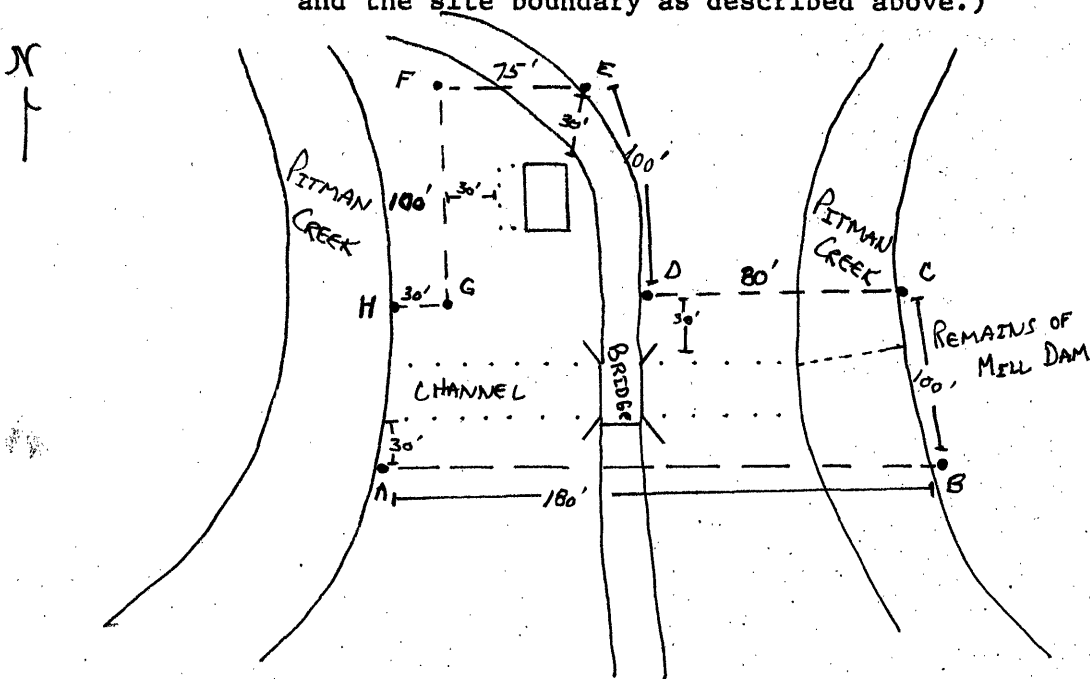

Verbal Boundary Description Acreage @ .7 ACRES

Beginning at point A, 30' downstream from the intersection of the southern edge of the channel and the eastern bank of Pitman Creek, thence in a straight line parallel to the channel and 30' south of said channel to a point on the eastern bank of Pitman Creek E of the point of beginning, approximately 180'; thence N along the eastern bank of Pitman Creek as it meanders to a point C downstream from the eastern most edge of the mill dam remains; thence in a straight line W parallel to the channel and 30' north of said channel to point D on the eastern edge of a road, approximately 80'; thence N along the eastern edge of said road as it meanders approximately 100' to point E, said point 30' N of the NE corner of the mill buildings; thence in a straight line W, said line running parallel to said mill building and 30' N of building's facade approximately 75' to point F; thence S in a line parallel to and 30' W of said building's W facade approximately 100' to point G; thence W in a straight line parallel to and 30' N of said channel approximately 30' to the eastern edge of Pitman Creek; thence S as Pitman Creek meanders to the beginning. Said boundaries are to include a channel cut through the neck of land separating the eastern and western portions of Pitman Creek, the remains of a mill dam, and the building lately known as Montgomery's Mill.
