SIGNIFICANCE	The Eliphalet Howd House was first recorded in the W.P.A. survey and dated 1754 based on a marker. Land record research is inconclusive but indicates the possibility of a date as early as the 1730's. Hewn overhangs suggest a date not later than the third quarter of the 18th century.				
	Architecturally, the Eliphalet Howd House represents the typical full two-story, central chimney New England house as it evolved at the close of the Second Period, 1691-1720 (Keith). It is significant in Branford's collection of eighteenth-century houses for its integrity of location, design, setting, materials and workmanship. As an example of eighteenth-century colonial architecture, it meets Criteria C of the National Register of Historic Places.
