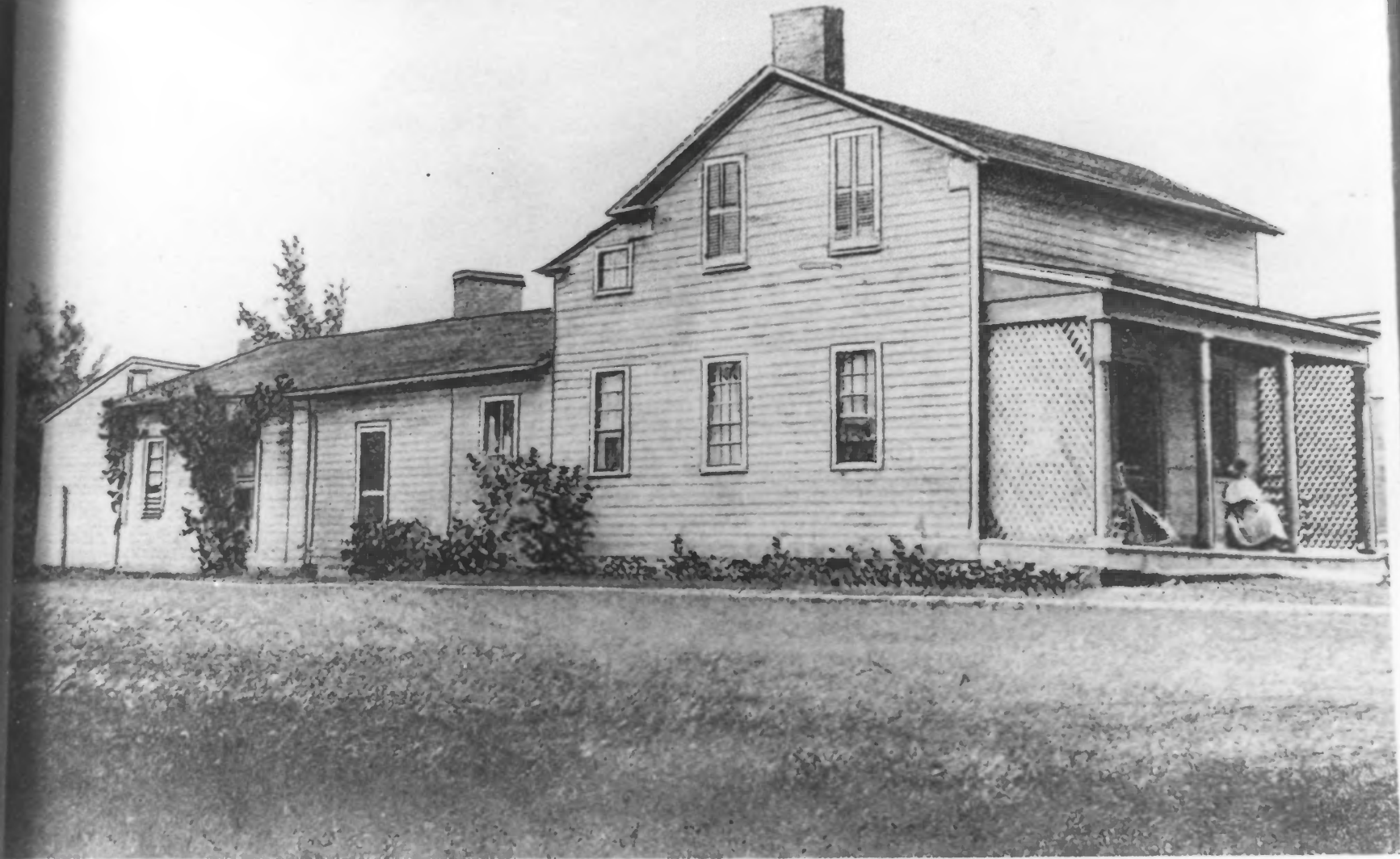

Mr. and Mrs. Irving Price purchased this house in 1930 which had been the home of the 13th President of the United States, Millard Fillmore, and his wife, Abigail, in 1823. It formerly stood for many years on the site of the present Aurora Theatre and later had been moved to Millard Fillmore Pl., in back

of the theater, where it was left unoccupied and subject to decay. The Prices moved the little house to a wooded plot on Shearer Ave. and with painstaking care completely restored the homestead. (See "Smatterings" for story.) Loaned to us by Mrs. James H. Bower of Sycamore St. and Mrs. Price.
