DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The University of Idaho Administration building is a massive three story red brick Tudor-Gothic building with a U-shaped plan. An outset central bay, rising above the rest of the structure, dominates the facade. This bay is penetrated by a two story corbelled, cast stone, Tudor arched entry. Octagonal towers contribute to the vertical thrust of the bay, which terminates with a highly decorated battlement.

Three steep gabled dormers with finials on either side of the entry bay continue the castle-like effect, as do the chimneys. The two wings' gables employ the dormers' motif as well. The north wing has a thousand seat auditorium which contains stained glass windows.

The exterior of the building remains unaltered although the interior has been renovated and the building has been reroofed in metal, replacing the tile originally used.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The University of Idaho Administration building is architecturally significant as a good example of the collegiate Gothic style in Idaho. Nothing in the state is comparable to the building's entry bay which has come to be symbolic of the University itself.

The University of Idaho was founded in 1892. The present Administration building replaced an early structure which burned in 1906.

The main body of the building was designed by Tourtellotte and Company, Idaho's foremost architectural firm. The north wing was completed in 1912 with Preusse and Zittle of Spokane being the architects. The south wing, designed by Curtis Richardson of Lewiston, was started in 1916 and enlarged in the 1930's.
