

Physical Description

This large, two-story house is characterized by fine details and an attractive rustic, picturesque quality. The intricacy and variety of the textures, patterns and rhythmic elements of the facade are offset by the simplicity of the massing and thus saved from lapsing into quaintness. The massing consists of the principal rectangular block, capped by a tile gable end roof, a projecting central cross gable and a recessed wing on the south. A wide, full-length front porch with shed roof accentuated by exposed rafters, adds horizontality and unity to the whole. The main block is faced with brick while the entire second story of the recessed wing and the cross gable are enlivened by stucco panels and pseudo half-timbering featuring decorative cut-out shapes. Adding further pattern to the cross gable are two multi-paned casement windows at attic level and a bank of four multi-paned sash windows below. The slight curve of the central portion of the porch roof is echoed in the large curved brackets which frame the porch entrance and each brick porch pier. The front door has a full-length multi-paned window and is flanked by multi-paned sidelights. The sash windows have six-over-one lights.

Statement of Significance

The Howson House was designed by the Thompson and Harding firm in 1918. Located at a busy intersection in Pine Bluff, the house is a picturesque combination of Craftsman and Tudor Revival styling. The design of the house is notable in its free and exuberant handling of textures and materials. The picturesque quality of the Howson House design is underlined by the lack of "quaint" features such as Jacobean chimneys or pseudothatched roofs. Although the firm designed many similarly styled houses few are of such a grand scale. The house displays by way of its symmetry an unusual formality for a Craftsman/Tudor Revival house. This house bears a resemblence to Theo Sanders' 1917 design for the Cornish House in Little Rock (PU-144). Despite the variety and intricacy of detailing found on the Howson House, it retains the character of an imposing large scale design with a measurable attention to unity.


