19. History Frederick Stucky was a tailor in Jeffersontown between 1820 and 1840. He is believed to have built this house about 1840, when he retired from his tailoring business. He farmed for the remainder of his life. In 1835 he was a trustee of Jeffersontown.																														
20. Significance The Stucky House is a brick structure built on the hall-parlor plan. Relatively few houses of this plan exist in the rural areas of Jefferson County.
