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Walla Lutheran Church, constructed in 1902, is located in rural Roberts County near the community of New Effington. The property includes the church, associated cemetery and a storage shed.

The façade faces south onto 105<sup>th</sup> Street. The Gothic Revival church is constructed of wood with a concrete foundation. The church consists of a steep gable roof covered in asphalt shingles, a projecting steeple section and a small room on the rear elevation. Common elements on the church include gothic arch windows with tracery and wood clapboard siding.

The façade (south elevation) has a projecting steeple with a central double door entry, which is topped by a stained glass arched window with wood tracery. Concrete steps with concrete wing walls lead up to the entry. The second floor of the steeple has a pair of gothic arch windows set inside a larger gothic arch. Above the second floor window is a hipped roof capped by a square room. Each elevation of the square room has a square vent in a large gothic arch. The gable ends of each elevation have gingerbread details. The steeple is capped by an eight sided conical roof with a weathervane at the peak. East of the steeple section, is a one story hipped roof room. It has an entry door leading to the basement and main floor. The steeply pitched gable roof has gable returns on the façade.

The east elevation has five one-over-one windows at the basement level. The main floor of the church has three gothic arch windows with tracery. The east elevation of the small room at the northeast corner has one gothic arch window with tracery.

The rear (north elevation) has a small room at both the northeast and northwest corners. The north elevations each have an entry door that is accessed by a flight of stairs. Between each of the rooms is a five sided room, which on the interior, houses the altar. There are two gothic arched windows with tracery in this portion. This room is capped with a conical roof. A curved chimney extends above the roof on this elevation. The steeply pitched gable roof has gable returns on the north elevation.

The west elevation has four one-over-one windows at the basement level. The main floor of the church has three gothic arch windows with tracery. The west elevation of the small room at the northwest corner has one gothic arch window with tracery.

#### Interior:

The sanctuary has many ornate details. The barrel vaulted ceiling is covered with a pressed metal in an elaborate pattern. The altar has a U-shaped communion rail. The altar is constructed in three

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sections that are triangular at the top with decorative finials. The center panel has a mural. The side panels also have a gothic arch and are separated from the center panel with narrow columns. To the left of the altar is a matching pulpit. The basement also has a pressed metal ceiling.

### Cemetery:

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The cemetery is located on the west and east sides of the church. It has been in continuous use since approximately 1895. There are approximately 320 interments.

#### Shed:

The shed roof wood clapboard building was constructed in circa 1900. It has a door at the southwest corner. There are no other openings.

### Significance

The Walla Lutheran Church is significant under Criterion C as a well preserved example of a Gothic Revival style and represents the second generation church construction in the eastern portion of the State of South Dakota.

Roberts County is located in the northeast corner of South Dakota. It is bordered on the east by Lake Traverse and Big Stone Lake. During the summer of 1883, Roberts County was officially organized.

The church body was first organized in 1894 as the Swedish Walla Evangelical Luther Church. Church services were held in a small facility until February 1902 when a vote was taken to construct a new church. By October 1902, all but the interior work was completed. Also located on the property historically was a privy to the north of the church.

The Walla Lutheran Church is significant under Criterion C as it typifies the "second generation" of church construction in the eastern portion of South Dakota. Structures that are constructed as a second generation church are those building from 1915 forward. While this building is outside the second generation time frame, it is still a second generation church as it was the second facility constructed for this congregation. Second generation churches typically exhibit an increased focus on stylistic interpretation of religion and a commitment to creating an impressive house of worship. These buildings are larger in size, scale and massing than their earlier counterparts and are more identifiable as being influenced by the Gothic Revival, Romanesque Revival or Classical Revival styles of ecclesiastical architecture.
