TATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE			
The Harman⊸Wa	tson-Matthews Hou	se built a 1860	by Luther Merrima

When slaves made brick for the Harmon-Watson-Matthews House, it was intended that they make enough for two houses, but the kiln collapsed and only the Harman house was built. Its owner, Luther Merriman Harman, was born in Chatam County, North Carolina, February 16, 1817, and had moved with his parents from North Carolina to Monroe County, Georgia and then to Meriwether County in the fall of 1827 in time for the land rush established by the Georgia legislature. In 1845 Harman was married to Catherine M.

Soon after Luther Merriman Harman's death in 1892, the house was sold to Robert Watson, whose family owned it until William M. Matthews purchased it in 1971.

The house, as an architectural example, is significant for its bold, four square room central hall plan, its original wood graining and the fact it was of brick construction. With the possible future addition of the temp form portico, the restoration that Matthews began in 1971 would be nearer completion. He had been proceeding with this alone, before hearing of the Register, to make the house liveable as a weekend retreat; with the Historical Commission's advice and new historical data, he intends to renovate as close to the documents as possible; the "colonial style" brick steps, for example, will be replaced by a copy of the original porch known from an 1896 photograph which turned up during the research to complete this form.
