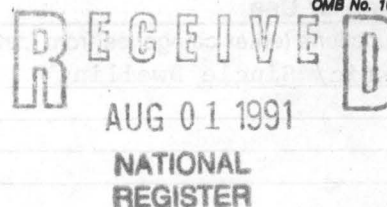

Description

The Berry House is a single story, wood frame Craftsman residence. Its end gable plan is fundamentally rectangular. The roof is covered with composition shingles, the walls are sheathed in novelty siding, and the structure is supported on brick piers.

The western or main elevation consists of a central gable end porch attached to the gable end of the main house. The porch roof features exposed rafters on the side and is supported by four sloping wood columns which rest upon low brick pedestals. Brick stoops flank the entrance which accesses a low concrete porch floor. A central entrance in the wall is flanked by two pairs of three-over-one wood sash windows. Three more pairs of these same windows light the northern and southern elevations and are placed in identical locations on both, even including the rear, hipped roof shed. The exposed rafters along the side cornices constitute the only other decoration.

The Berry House has not been significantly altered and is in good condition.

Significance

Criterion C, local significance

The Berry House (Part E, Historic Context #4) is the best example in Beebe of a single story, wood frame, front gabled Craftsman style residence. Constructed c. 1930, this house is typical of the third period in the evolution of Craftsman style designs in White County. Its floor plan has become very regular and symmetrical and features only the vestiges of the irregularity of plan and elevation which was one of the hallmark features of this building style.
