## ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

One-story T-plan frame residence with undercut gallery on front facade. Entrance frontispiece with six-panel door framed by engaged square columns, side lights and transom, and pilasters that support a full entablature. Front steps are inset so that they are beneath the gallery. Center-hall plan.

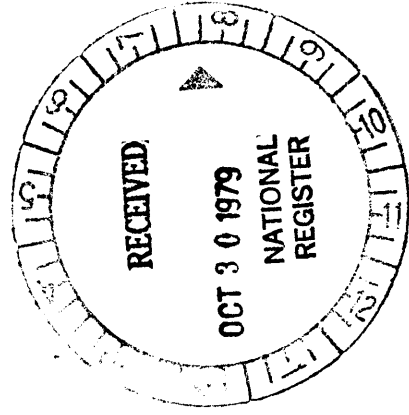
