Bridge 62-220-512 carries a local road over the Keya Paha River approximately 1.5 miles west and 1.5 miles north of Wewela. The 60' single span structure is a riveted and bolted Pratt pony truss. The upper chord consists of two steel channel sections riveted with a continuous steel cover plate along their upper flanges and with lacing bars riveted along their lower flanges. The lower chord and diagonals both consist of two angle sections riveted together with batten plates. The verticals are comprised of four angle sections riveted together with batten plates. Sway bracing consists of two angle sections riveted together in a triangular pattern on the exterior of the truss verticals. Bottom lateral bracing consists of two steel angle sections. The timber deck rests on I-beam stringers which in turn are bolted to haunches on the I-beam floor beams. The floor beams are bolted to the superstructure. There is no bridge railing on this structure.

Although the abutments do not appear to be original, the integrity of the truss is good and it appears to be unaltered.

8. Signficance

Bridge no. 62-220-512 is being nominated to the National Register of Historic Places as part of the "Historic Bridges in South Dakota" Multiple Property Nomination. It is related to the historic context of "Historic Bridges in South Dakota, 1893-1943" and is classified with the associated property type for iron and steel frame bridges. This bridge is individually eligible for the National Register under Criterion C as the only surviving example in South Dakota of a standardized design for a truss bridge developed by the Standard Bridge Company of Omaha, Nebraska. The bridge retains good integrity.

The Standard Bridge Company was organized in Omaha by Robert Z. Drake in 1900. Drake was born and educated in Kansas and began building bridges in the early 1890s when he was in his early twenties. Besides working as a contractor, he was an innovator in developing a configuration of steel pilings for bridge substructures and the transverse joist bridge. He also developed standardized plans for truss bridges that were widely used in Nebraska and elsewhere. The Standard Bridge Company held the annual bridge contract in Tripp County in 1914, the year this bridge was built.

Included in the state wide survey of South Dakota's historic bridges were 15 surviving bridges built by the Standard Bridge Company. Among these, Bridge No. 62-220-512 is the only known surviving example in South Dakota of the Standard Bridge Company's standardized trusses.
