DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Old Southeast Watering Trough is a six-foot granite structure composed of a rectangular shaft or column and a large 6' bowl and two small dispensing pipes. Four small cups appear at the base to provide refreshment for fauna. The fountain rests on a base of tiles at an intersection of streets in a fast deteriorating neighborhood of Des Moines.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Old Southeast Watering Trough is a survivor of the horse and buggy age. It is a visible reminder of an earlier period of public utilities technology designed to meet mass needs prior to the introduction of indoor plumbing. Places such as these served a social function as well, for they provided focal points where a community's residents engaged in social exchange.

This is one of the last of 15 horse watering troughs installed around Des Moines by the Iowa Humane Alliance, established in 1883. As one of two Ensign fountains presented to the city in 1906, this structure still provided water for an area of Des Moines referred to as the "Southeast Bottoms". It was presented to the city by the National Humane Alliance, to honor their founder, Herman Lee Ensign. The other fountain presented by the Society was located at S.E. 6th and Hartford Avenues, and was later moved close to the entrance of Owen Crist Farm, 3800 Park Ave.

Increased interest by the citizens of the area and the Des Moines City Council has led to the desire to have the water trough preserved as a neighborhood landmark.
