III. Physical description of property and historic significance

Island Home has a central hall plan, two rooms deep, with a rear "L" wing. The five bay facade has an unusual entrance with the side lights extending to the height of the transom. Changes include the loss of the two chimneys, the loss of one of the light aedicule style mantels, the enclosure of part of the rear gallery and the installation of a false gallery in front. In our view these changes have not disqualified the house for the Register because it is still possible to appreciate Island Home's basic Neo-Classical lines and style.
