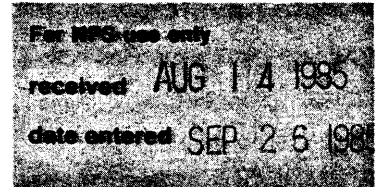

4. Owner: Sammy Martinez, 1524 8th, Las Vegas, N.M.
7. Description: Foundation material unknown; stuccoed and brick walls; new windows and doors; stuccoed transom; simple metal cornice; elaborate double recessed panel with rosettes; pressed metal cornice with dentils and scroll brackets. Brick wall with stepping parapet on side. Located at the eastern end of the Plaza/Bridge Street commercial area, east of the river.
8. Significance: Built between 1889 and 1902, this is a modest-sized but fully detailed World's Fair Classic building. The original doors and windows have been replaced and the transom is covered, but the original brick work and pressed metal details above remain intact. It is one of three relatively unaltered buildings (ill. 28, 29) in the half block extension of the Plaza/Bridge Street commercial area which reached across the river toward New Town at the turn of the century. By 1930, this building had already served as a hardware store, a grocery, a notions shop, and a bakery.
