DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Description

Foundation sandstone

Walls are of locally made red brick. Common bond used. Windows are double hung with a single lite to each sash. Windows and doors have rounded arches of brick above them. Much elaborate brickwork below frieze and about windows. The suggestion of horse shoes is made by the brick ornamentation around the first floor windows.

The house faces east and is basically square in plan.

A two story porch frames the main entry on the east facade. The porch columns of wood are solid and squarish with slight flat trimming of wood. The porch rises two stories to support a second story landing and room size "dormer" which projects from the main roof. Room dormer has hipped gable roof with wood shingle

covering.

Cresting tops the ridge line.

Main roof is mansard with dormer windows. Tall wood cresting enclosed the top of main roof. Below cresting is a wide wood frieze. Below cornice of main roof is a simple wood frieze. Below frieze is elaborate brick detailing in "sawtooth" pattern. Main roof is wood shingle.

The gable portion of the room size dormer is trimmed with bargeboard. Within the pediment is a wood carving of a horse's head approximately life size.


