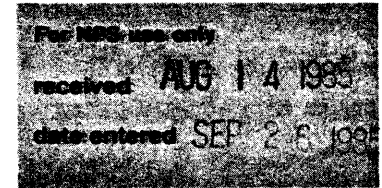

4. Owner: Geo. V. Wilson, 1616 8th, Las Vegas, N.M.
7. Description: Rectangular shape with short side to the street; rusticated light brown random ashlar sandstone foundation and walls; asphalt shingle roof; wood shingles in gables; small eaves overhang with exposed rafters; 1/1, 6/6 double-hung windows with sandstone sills and lintels; stone bases with caps, boxed tapered porch piers with molding "bases" and "capitals," frieze board. Located in a residential block four blocks north of the North New Town District.
8. Significance: This is the last of the six nominated houses of the Eighth Street Extension, discussed earlier with Building #1511. By about 1910, when this house was built, rusticated random ashlar sandstone work of this sort was normally limited to foundation walls. The limited details here are drawn from the local version of the Bungalow Style: tapered piers, exposed rafters and gable shingles.
