

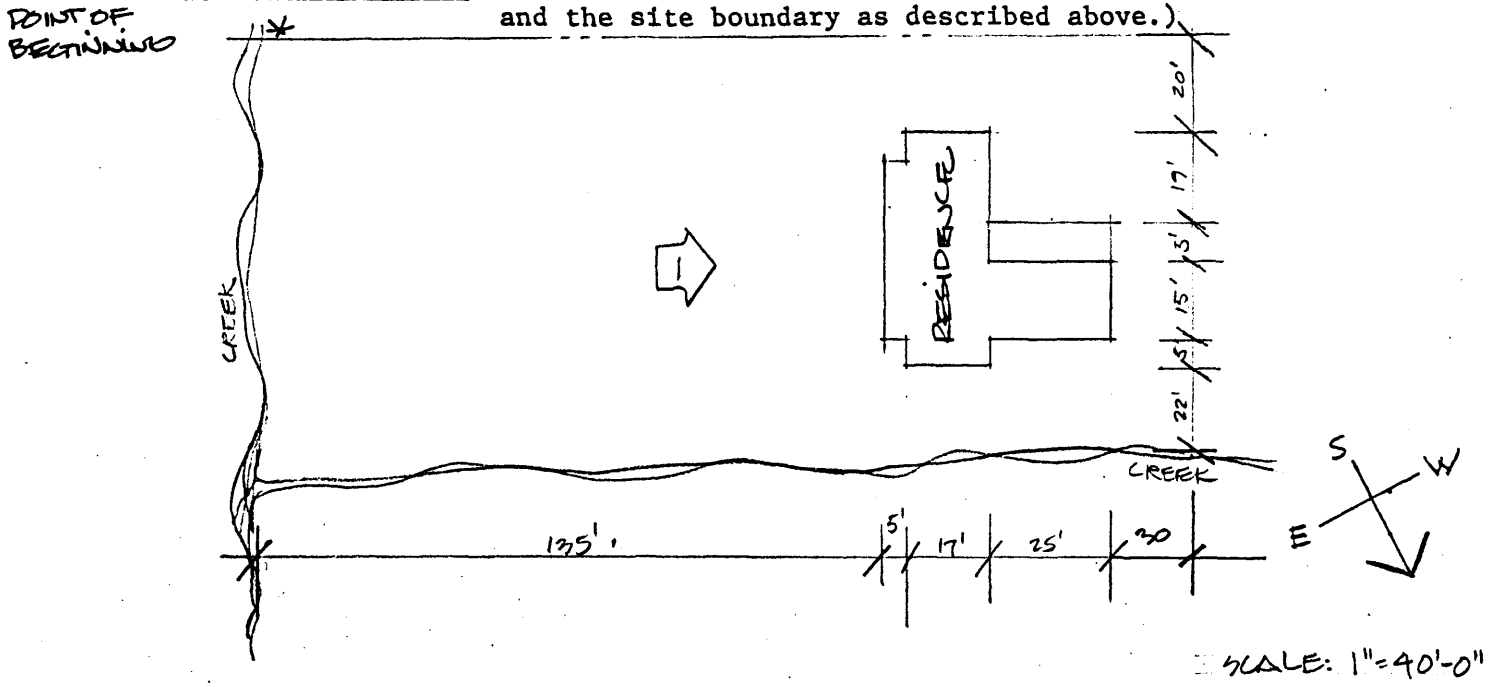

From a point of beginning which is .1 mile northwest of Middle Fork of Jenny's Creek; then 202 feet northwest; then 86 feet northeast to the Creek; then with the Creek approximately 200 feet to the point of beginning.

The boundary contains all of the domestic space associated with the dwelling and one contributing building.
