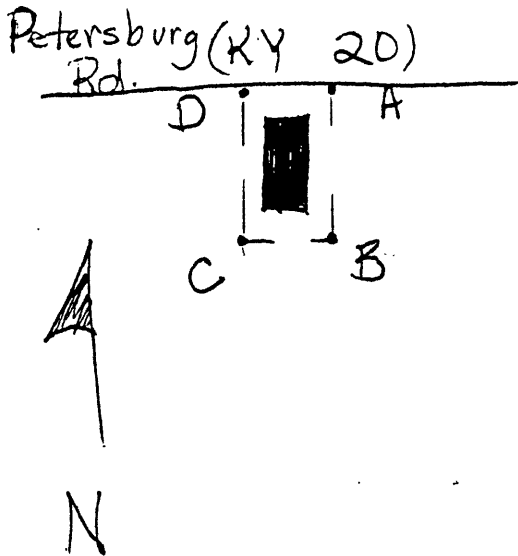

44. Site Plan (and boundary description and justification for N.R. sites):

The nominated property occupies the west 50' of city lot 31.

The boundary, a rectangle marked by points A, B, C, and D, includes the building and part of the city lot historically associated with the property. Boundary D-A is on the south side of KY 20.

45. Description and House Plan:

Located to the east of the main crossroads of Hebron, the Deposit Bank is a small rectangular building facing north. Its primary characteristics are its diminutive scale and its eccentric roof form, a kind of mix of mansard, boomtown and shed-roof forms. Except for the reworking of the high porch at the streetfront entrance, the building is unchanged. The narrow facade consists of only a door and a window; the window and the transoms are fixed panes, and the facade wall is of tan brick, whereas the other three walls are of red brick. There are sash windows on the sides, two on the left (east) and one of the right. All lintels and sills are stone. The roof is covered with the original diamond-shaped shingles.

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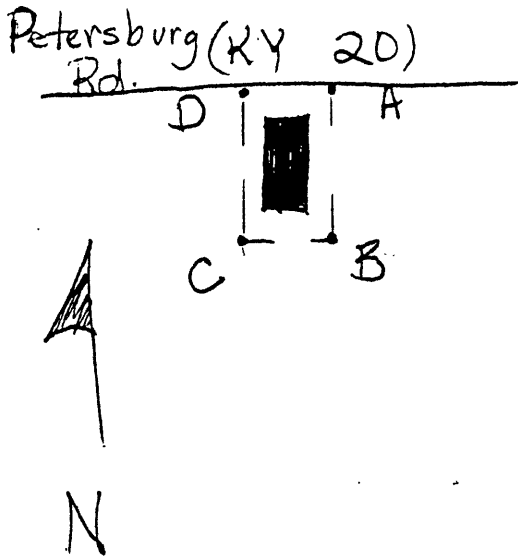
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
