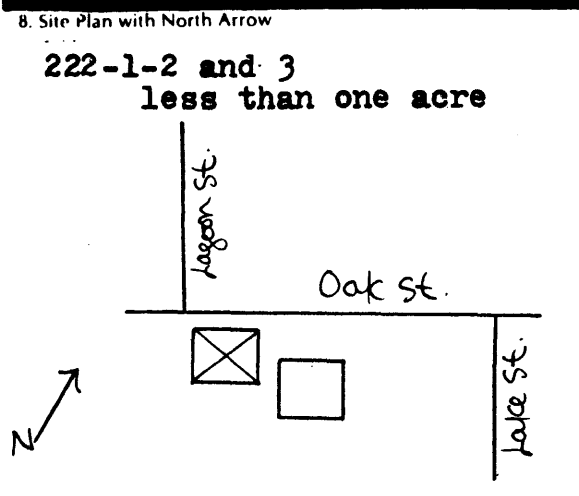

West facade has similar trim; French doors, triple windows, and center bay with hip roof. East facade same as west, but has (over)
