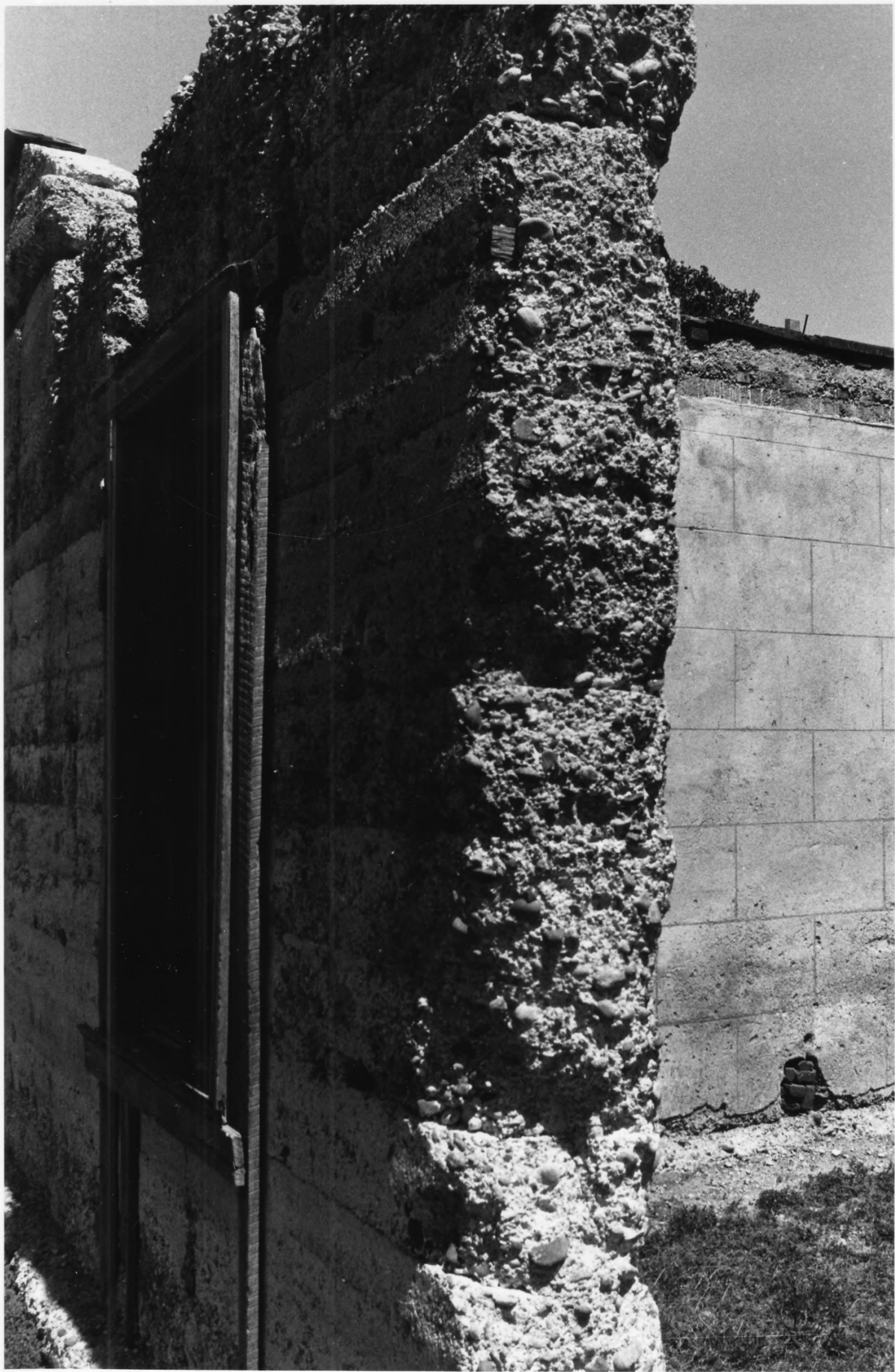

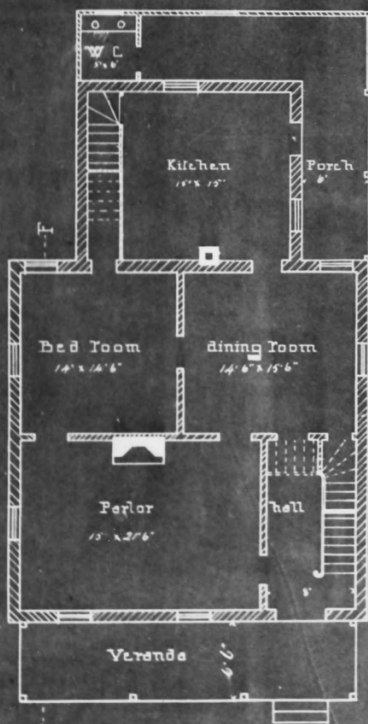

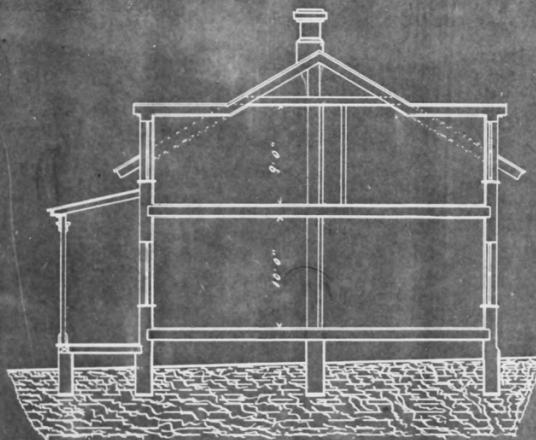
Front Elevation



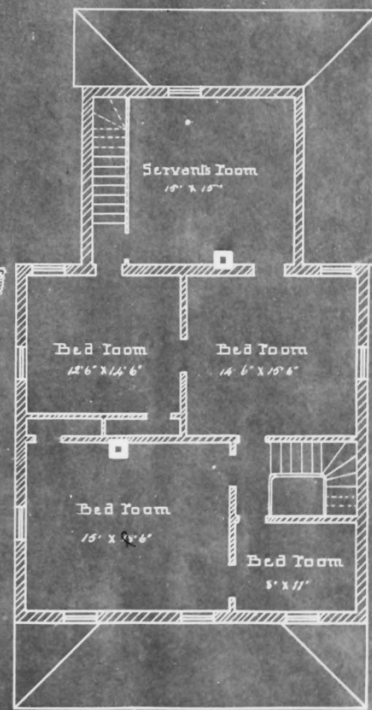
End Elevation
