DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Richland-West End is a neighborhood comprising roughly twelve blocks located three miles southwest of downtown Nashville. Within this area are 365 buildings, only 38 of which are not consistent with the architectural and historic character of the district. Richland-West End was laid out on a gentle slope which rises gradually to the east. Most of the area's streets and the medians in Richland, Christopher, Craighead and Bowling Avenues are lined with large maple trees which create a pleasant shade in the summer and bring breathtaking beauty in the fall.

The area is bounded on the north by a Louisville and Nashville railroad right-of-way and by Murphy Road, a major thoroughfare. The eastern border is Park Circle which borders an area cleared for an Interstate highway right-of-way and the wester border is formed by Wilson Blvd. which divides Richland-West End from an area developed somewhat later and consequently of different architectural character. While the Richland-West End area continued to the south to West End Avenue, another major traffic artery, a number of sizable intrusions on West End and along the south side of two blocks of Richland Avenue call for drawing the southern boundary of the district along the alley between Richland and West End Avenues and along Richland. These boundaries for the most part coincide with those chosen by the neighborhood association, Richland-West End Neighbors, Inc.

Richland-West End Neighbors, Inc. is an active neighborhood organization, which has effectively sought to reduce zoning and codes violations, improve city services, and encourage renovation work and proper yard and building maintenance in the area. Richland West End is also the location of the Free Will Baptist College, a religious institution with an enrollment of about 550. The Bible College has bought a number of lots in the area, converting the houses on some to academic use and tearing down others to make way for modern buildings. While the college has no set campus boundaries, its "campus" is generally concentrated in the 3600 block of Richland Avenue and on West End Avenue, most of which is not included in the district boundaries.

The bungalow is the predominant building type in Richland-West End. Over two-thirds of the 361 residential buildings in the district are bungalows or bungalow-type houses. This is one of the largest and best preserved concentrations of bungalow architecture in Nashville. As in most bungalow neighborhoods, the houses themselves vary widely within the general parameters of the bungalow style. Their construction dates range from about 1910 through the 1920s. Exterior materials include wood, (3814 Central, 311 Greenway) brick (3536 Central), stucco (506 Wilson) and stone (3726 Richland). Sizes range from diminutive (3700 Princeton) to large (3700 Central) or, as in the case of 3512 Central, too large to qualify as a true bungalow.

A second common building type, with some 70 examples in Richland-West End, is a house frequently called the four-square. The four-square is a square, two-story house, larger than the true bungalow and dating from about the same time period. The roof, usually shingle but occasionally tile, is typically a concave pyramid pierced by a single attic dormer on all four sides. Exteriors are finished in brick, stone and occasionally stucce Frequently a brick or stone first story is combined with shingles on the second. Additional variety is produced by the style and form of the nearly always present front porch. This

can range from an entrance portico to a full width veranda. In many cases the porch is supported by classical columns (3719 Central, 3708 Richland, 3712 Richland), in others by battered, bungalow-type supports (3716 Richland).

Also within the Richland-West End area are a number of modest houses referred to herein as post-bungalow cottages. These houses, mostly built in the 1920s, are similar in size and layout to the bungalow but are different in decorative detail. Typically built of red brick, the post-bungalow cottage replaces the large bungalow front porch with a small, square, often arched entry porch. Eave overhangs are much diminished and bungalow-type eave brackets are gone. Often gables are decorated with a wood and stucco half-timber effect. Houses at 3518 Richland, 3706 Princeton and 3725 Richland are good examples.

The most important single structure in the district is the John Brown Craighead house located at 3710 Westbrook Avenue. Built about 1812 of bricks fired on the site, it is one of the oldest brick houses in Nashville. The simple two-story house originally had two rooms over two; a wing was added later to the rear forming an "L" shape. The principal facade features a simple four columned porch over the central entry flanked by nine-over-nine paned windows. Three similar windows light the second floor. Chimneys are located on the windowless short sides of the original section.

Buildings inconsistent with the early 20th century period and character of Richland-West End are few and, as a group, relatively unobtrusive. Most are small, brick single-family houses or duplexes dating from the 1950s and 60s. Scale and setbacks are generally consistent with older neighbors and the level of maintenance is high. The Concordia Lutheran Church at 211 Park Circle, while built in 1937 and therefore technically an intrusion, is by virtue of its architectural style and its scale, a welcome part of the neighborhood fabric.

Two buildings built by the Free Will Baptist Bible College, Goen Hall and Polston Hall, are genuinely intrusive elements. Both three story flat roofed buildings of red brick are out of scale with their surroundings and architecturally incompatible with the styles typical of Richland-West End.

Taken as a whole, however, Richland-West End presents a largely unaltered picture of the suburban building scene in Nashville during the first three decades of this century, ranging from the large comfortable homes of the upper middle class to the more modest bungalows. Incompatible elements are few. Richland-West End is a strikingly harmonious and cohesive whole.

#### STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Part of the significance of the Richland-West End area lies in the history of its land. Early in the 1800s John Brown Craighead owned a large estate which encompassed today's Richland-West End nieghborhood. The house in which he lived still stands and is the oldest house in the district. He was the son of Thomas B. Craighead, the first Presbyterian minister to settle in the Nashville area. John Craighead was married to Mrs. Jane Erwin Dickinson, who had been widowed in 1806 when her husband was killed in a duel with Andrew Jackson.

After the Civil War, the Craighead estate, like so many others, was divided and sold as Nashville began to grow to the west. Today's Richland-West End neighborhood began to take shape in 1905 when the Richland Realty Company purchased a large tract of Craighead land adjacent to West End Avenue and began the development of today's Richland-West End in four sections: subdivision "A" in April 1906, "B" in May 1910, "C" in April 1913, and Westlawn in April 1913.

Most of the people drawn to the developing neighborhood were professionals, who built comfortable, spacious houses. Often several members of the same family bought neighboring lots. Early residents included mayors, attorneys general, journalists, doctors, legislators and a Tennessee governor, Benton McMillin. The neighborhood was outside the city limits until the twenties.

Richland-West End remained basically stable until after World War II. Decline began as affluent residents moved farther out to new suburbs, and the post-war housing shortage prompted the conversion of many single-family dwellings to apartments and boarding houses. Today the area is regaining stability through the efforts of the neighborhood organization and a renewed awareness of the livability of older urban neighborhoods.

More significant than its history is Richland-West End's architectural excellence. With the exception of the Craighead house, whose presence is a constant reminder of the area's history, Richland-West End is a well-defined enclave of high quality early twentieth century domestic architecture. Construction continued in the area from its first subdivision in 1905 to well into the 1920s. The houses built here range in style and size from large luxurious homes to modest bungalows. With the bungalow in the overwhelming majority, Richland-West End streetscapes are widely varied in detail yet harmonious and consistent overall. Intrusive elements are few. Maintenance and landscaping are generally good. Richland-West End offers a higher concentration and a wider variety of well-dept earlier twentieth century houses than any other neighborhood in Nashville.
