


Photo #1: From highest point in Eastern Cemetery looking west towards Federal Street.

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

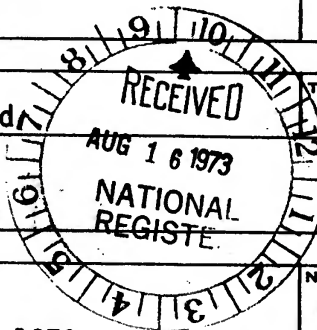


Photo #3: Longfellow stones towards the Northeast located near Federal Street.

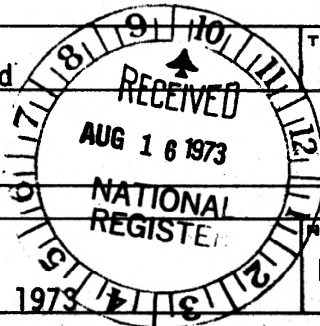

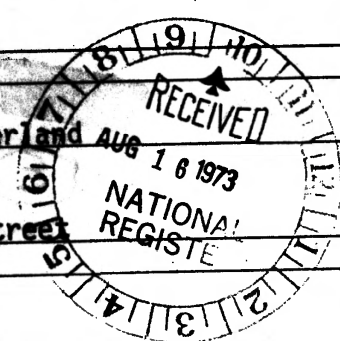


Photo #5: Tabitha Longfellow stone towards the East. Located in the SE half of the cemetery near Federal Street.

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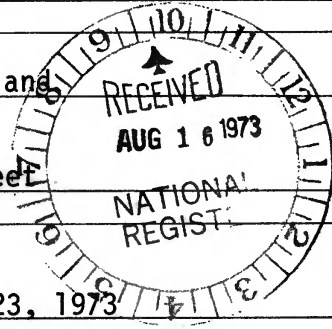



