Verbal Boundary Description

Beginning at point A (see U.S.G.S. map) on the east side of U.S. 62, the boundary runs southeast for approximately 1800 feet following the private drive to point B. The line then turns north for approximately 400 feet following the curve of the drive to point C. From point C, the line runs west for approximately 575 feet to point D on U.S. 62. The line follows the east side of U.S. 62 for approximately 600 feet to the point of origin.
