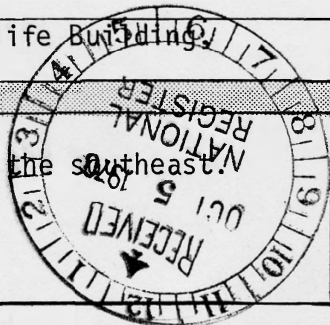

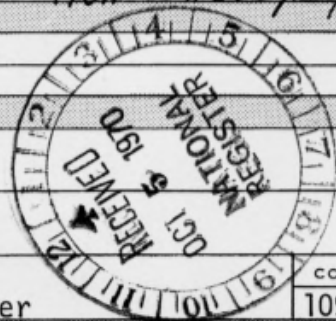

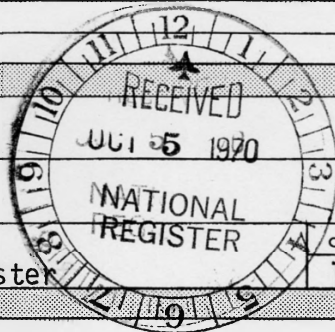

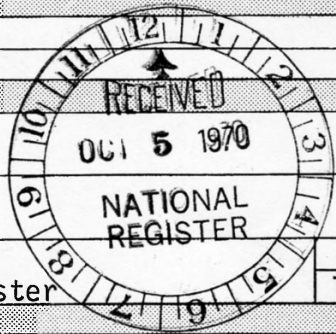

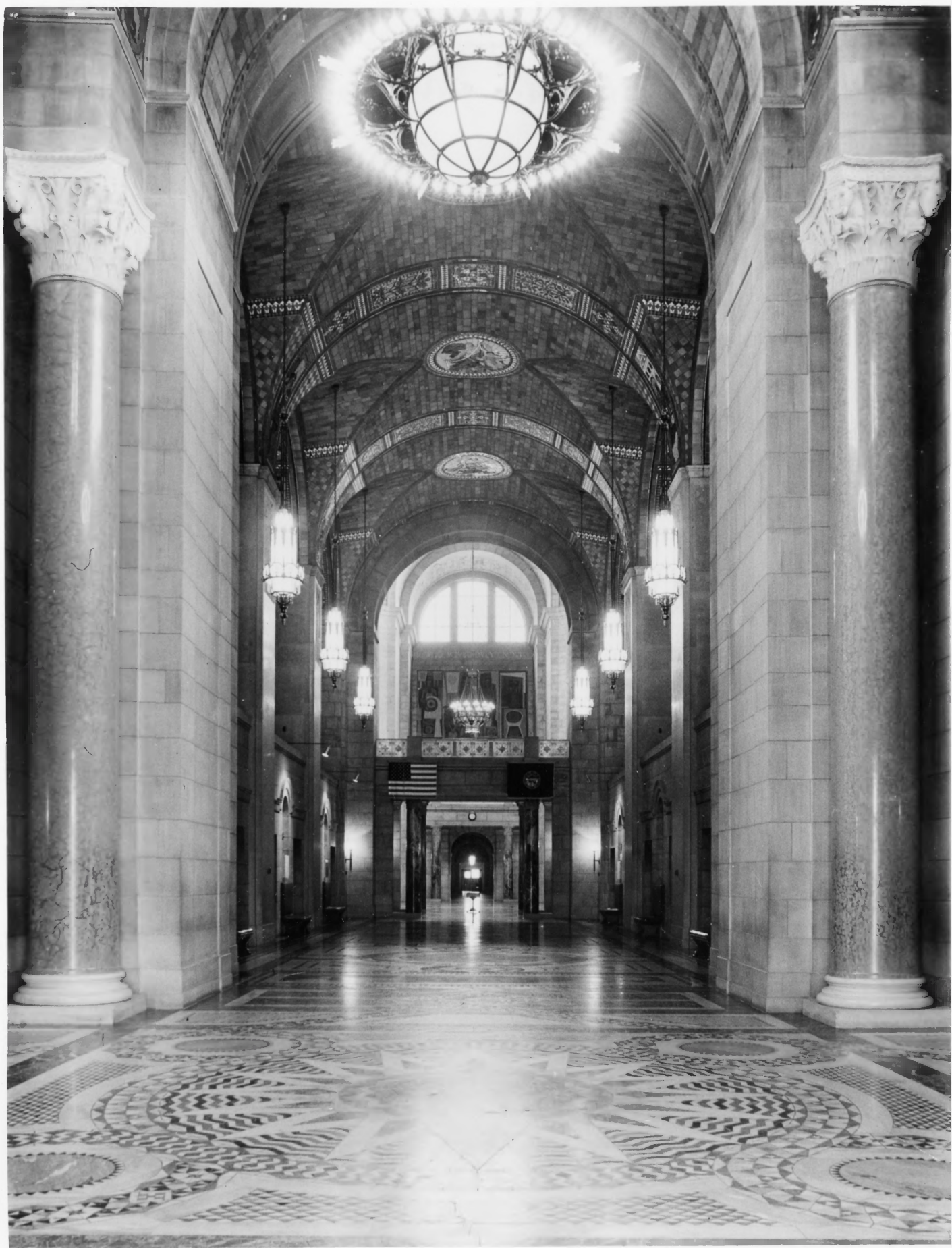

of the Siouy Indians.



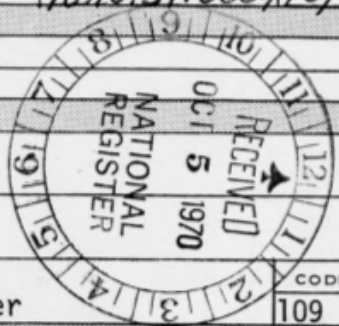

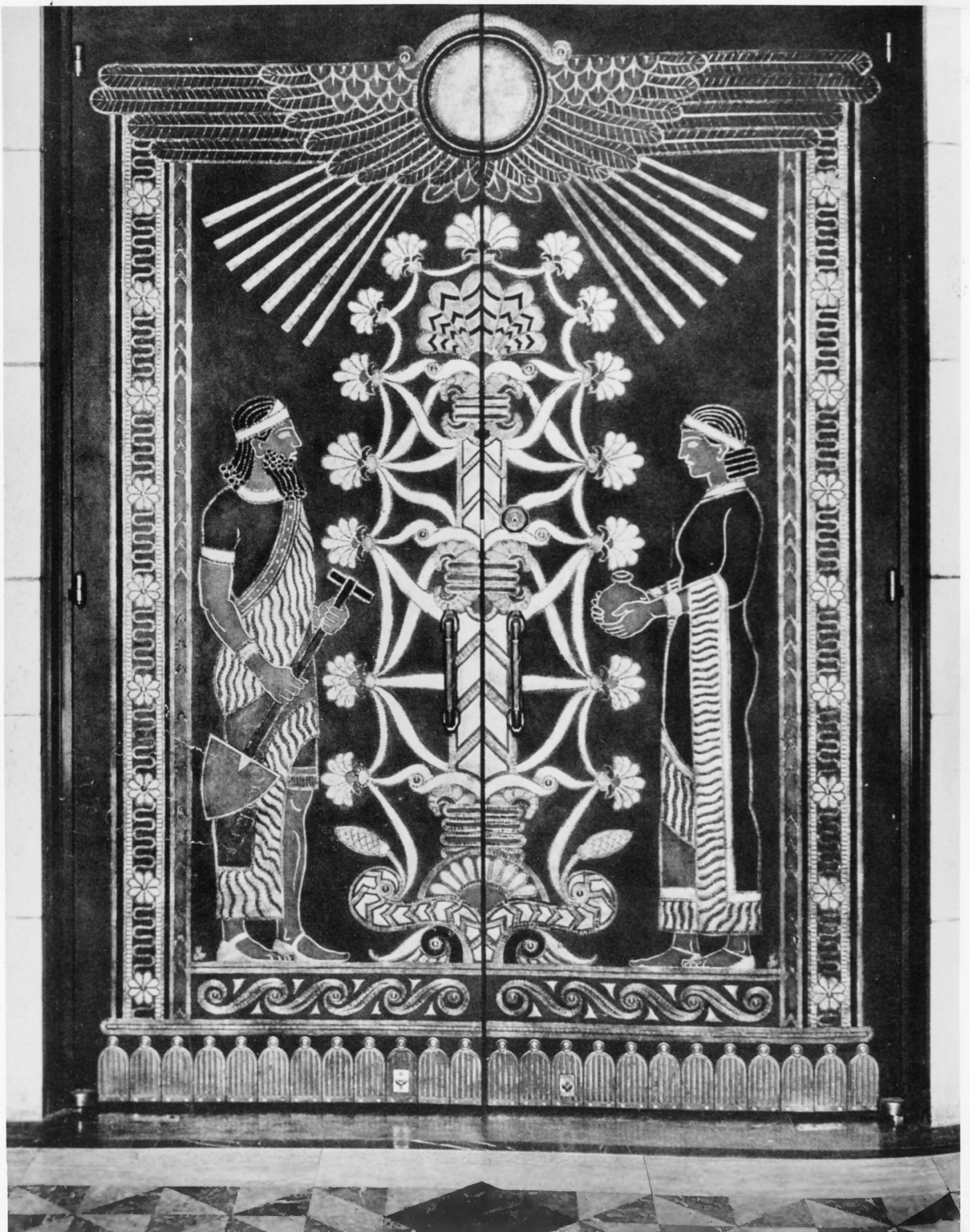
