III. Physical description of property and historical significance

Description: Large, square, pedimented frame church with pilasters at the corners and large square head windows. Front lancet windows, tower and interior beaver board paneling added in the early 20th century. Old pews remain complete with bar to separate men and women. Original structure is hewn. Adjacent modern school building excluded from boundaries.

Significance: This is a good representative example of the simple frame Greek Revival country churches which were built in many parts of the country during the 1840's and 50's. Although there have been modifications, the original building is still distinguishable. The modifications are typical of their own period and have acquired architectural value in their own right.
