The earlier features are the stone fabric, interior end chimneys, small attic windows, water table, breakfast mantles, paneled jambs, and chair rail. Later features are wider doorways (photo 4) front and rear w H.R. double doors, square corner stone door and window sills w vertical tooling, (photo 5) narrow mitered corner frames, J.R. trim, and 2 panel interior doors. An early porch spans the rear of the 2 story section. The entire house, wing, and kitchen have been stuccoed; 20th C hipped roof porch on front.

Early dependencies include a stone building (behind the kitchen) which has a braded pegged door frame (building also stuccoed), the foundation of the ill house in the back yard, and a log barn S of the house.

House located on prosperous working farm bordering Salt River. Rock fence along road and boundaries. Quarry between house and road.

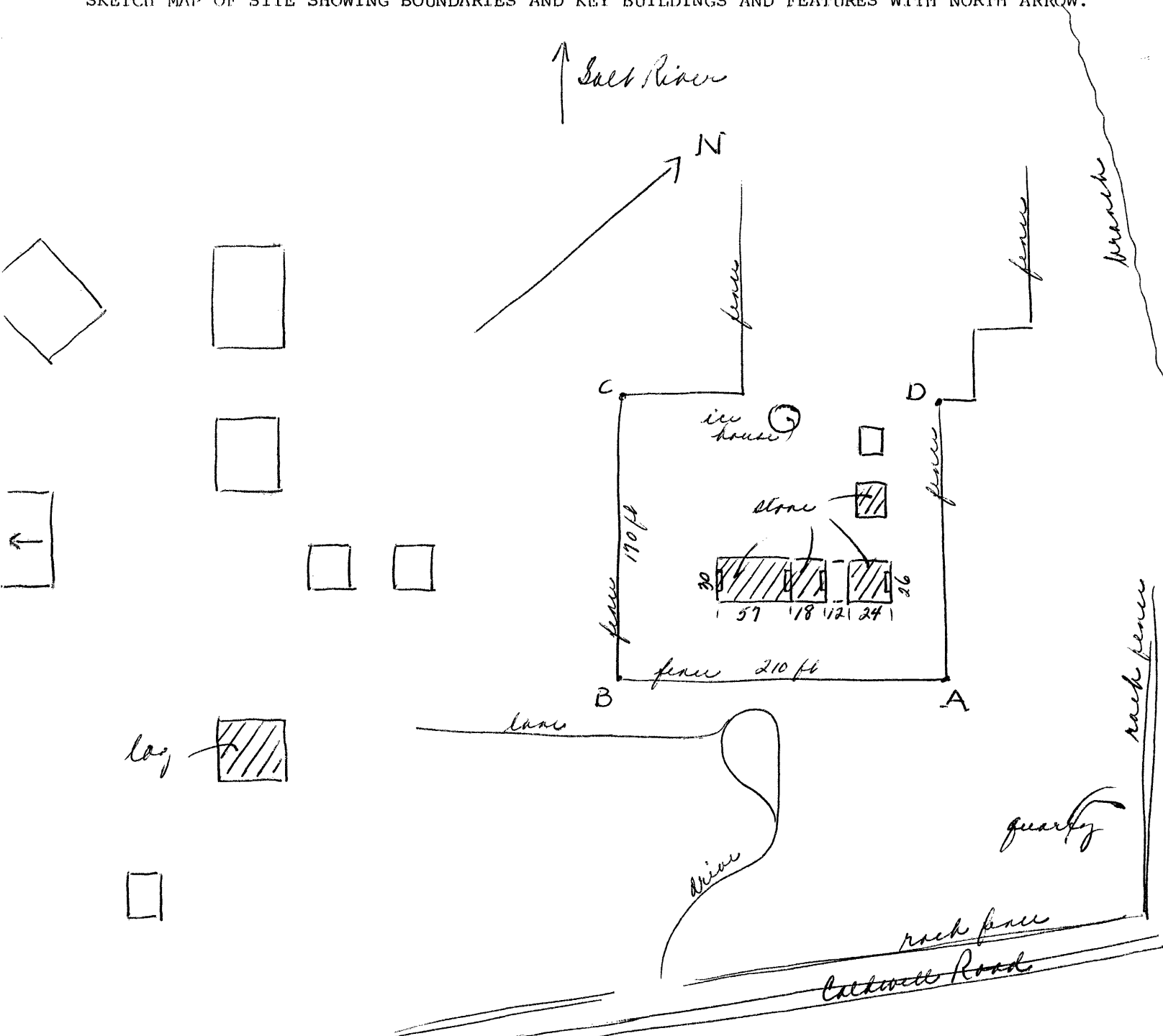

VERBAL BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION & JUSTIFICATION

Beginning at A at the E corner of the yard, thence SW 210 ft to B, NW 170 ft to C, NE 210 ft to D, and SE 170 ft to the beginning, containing the stone house, stone kitchen, stone grain house, stone ice house foundation, about 8/10 acre.
