7. Description

The Hay Creek Bridge is located within the City of Belle Fourche and carries Eighth Avenue over Hay Creek. The two-span multi-plate arch consists of semi-circular barrel arches with filled spandrels. The railings are metal pipe in concrete posts with concrete caps. Concrete brackets support a partially cantilevered sidewalk on the west side. The abutments are concrete with wing walls. "WPA, 1941" is set in the concrete on the east side.

This bridge has very good integrity.

8. Significance

The Hay Creek Bridge is being nominated to the National Register as part of the "Historic Bridges in South Dakota" Multiple Property It is related to the historic context of "Historic Bridges in South Dakota, 1893-1943" and is classified with the associated property type for multi-plate arch bridges. This bridge is individually eligible for the National Register under Criterion A for its association with the Works Progress Administration, a New Deal program design to provide work relief for the nation's unemployed during the Great Depression of the 1930s and early 1940s; and under Criterion C as a rare example in South Dakota of a multi-plate arch bridge. The bridge retains very good integrity.

President Roosevelt's New Deal programs of the 1930s, ushered in a new era of bridge construction in the South Dakota. The primary intent of these programs was to provide federal assistance to put as many men to work as possible during a time of severe economic crisis, the Great Depression. For bridge projects, in general, federal agencies paid for labor, while the state or local highway departments paid for supervision, engineering, and materials. Most assistance for bridge construction in South Dakota was provided by the Works Progress Administration (WPA) which supervised the bulk of New Deal work-relief projects from 1935 to the onset of World War II in 1942.

The mult-plate arch design of the Hay Creek bridge enjoyed a very brief period of popularity, confined almost entirely to the decade of the 1930s. During its heyday, however, the multi-plate arch seems to have provided a viable alternative to reinforced-concrete slab-and-girder (continued)

8. Significance (continued)

construction for short-span bridges. The simple modular design of multiplate construction made it an ideal choice for the unskilled, work-relief projects of the New Deal era. At the same time, multi-plate bridge design, by easily assimilating masonry or concrete headwalls and spandrels, satisfied New Deal priorities for roadside beautification and the encouragement of local craft skills.

The Hay Creek Bridge was built by the WPA, and the City of Belle Fourche in 1941. It is one of only two multi-plate arch bridges found to exist in South Dakota by the state wide inventory of historic bridges.
