


Physical Description

Designed by Charles Thompson around 1900, this house represents the firm's preference during this period for houses which combine Queen Anneverticality and asymmetrical massing with Colonial Revival decorative details. Raised high on a brick foundation the tall two-story structure is faced with weatherboards, and capped by a tall hipped roof from which projects a gabled dormer and a cross gable section featuring prominent gable returns. A large porch wraps the front and south side elevations. Embellishing this porch are the supporting Tuscan columns and a full entablature enriched by dentil molding and a balustrade of turned spindles which lines the porch on both upper and lower levels. The front door and sidelights of beveled glass are framed by a fluted architrave with stylized Ionic pilasters. In a more Queen Annevein is the decorative carved wood panel beneath two small arched windows which enriches the prominent cross gable.

Statement of Significance

The Thurston House at 923 Cumberland in Little Rock was designed by Charles L. Thompson ca. 1900. Located in the MacArthur Park Historic District, the Thurston House is an unusually formal and decorative version of many of the firm's transitional house designs featuring both Victorian and Colonial Revival elements. Decorative wood panels surrounding a second story window on the west facade serve as an unusual focal point on the house. Another unusually decorative feature on the Thurston House is the flat-roofed wrap-around porch which features Tuscan columns, a full entablature, and an upper balustrade of turned spindles. The vertical massing of the body of the house combined with the dominant porch with Colonial Revival detailing make the Thurston House distinctive in its neighborhood setting of simple Foursquare designs.


