Verbal Boundary Description:

The Josie Bassett Morris Ranch Complex is bounded on the east by a line running due north from a point twenty yards east and 100 yards south of the southeast mouth of Hog Canyon(Point A) to a point 200 yards north of the canyon mouth on its east side(Point B); west from that point for approximately 450 yards to a point 100 yards north and forty yards west of the north end of a row of Lombardy Poplar trees(Point C); thence south to a point 150 yards south of the south end of the Poplar tree line(Point D) and thence east for approximately 450 yards to Point A. These boundaries encompass all pertinent structures and the cultural landscape that surrounds them.
