

STATEMENT

This is an attractive and well-kept local example of small-scale housing in the Eastlake mode. Textured wall surfaces, a bracketted porch and paneled vergeboards are important features.

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DESCRIPTION

Charles F. Ranzow built this house in 1881, several years after erecting the C. F. Ranzow Building downtown. Ranzow operated a paint store under the style "C. F. Ranzow and Son." The firm also handled oils, doors, class, etc. Ranzow continued living at this address until 1885 when Julius Sander bought the house. Sander was employed in the hardware trade and established his own store in 1890.
