PATAGONIA HOTEL

JOHN H. CADY CAME TO ARIZONA AS A SOLDIER IN THE 1860'S AND WAS STATIONED AT FORT CRITTENDEN ON SONOITA CREEK. LATER CADY BECAME A RESIDENT OF PATAGONIA AND IN DECEMBER OF 1900 BEGAN BUILDING THE PATAGONIA HOTEL. HE CONTINUED TO ADD TO THE STRUCTURE UNTIL HE CONSIDERED IT THE FINEST OF ITS KIND IN THE COUNTRY.

NOW KNOWN AS CADY HALL, THE BUILDING IS THE HOME OF THE PATAGONIA WOMAN'S CLUB.
