PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION	
The Clark Residence is a two-story wood frame structure of asymmetrical massing. The floor plan is approximately 30 feet wide and 45 feet deep. A two-story bay window is

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE	
The Eli P. Clark House is a large home typical of the more affluent families in the pre-	
railroad era. Clark was co-owner of the Pioneer sawmill which supplied the Atlantic and Pacific Railroad with ties as it built across Arizona. In 1883 he used the proceeds from	
this contract to build a residence on the nor	theast corner of Gurley and Pleasant Streets
Sixteen years later Clark sold the property to	o a Dr. Pentland. For an as yet undetermine

For an as yet undetermined reason, Pentland then moved the house about seventy five feet north of its original site.
