<u>Outbuildings</u>:

Included is an underground cellar. The cellar contributes to the property as an original feature demonstrating the use of the domestic space surrounding the house and methods of food storage. It is a typical feature where a house id not provided with an interior cellar.

The boundaries encompass two contributing buildings.
