18. Description No. 4422 is a large, two and one-half story frame dwelling on a limestone foundation. A veranda across the front and most of the west side has a concrete balustrade. It is covered in front by a low, hipped porch roof supported by square, paneled pillars. The central, double doorway and flanking sidelights have leaded glass. A large, rectangular window on either side complete the ground floor facade. Directly above the entry is a pair of small windows, flanked again by larger ones. All these windows have one-		33. 19. History This residence was built in 1908 for Peter C. Doerhoefer, vice-president of the Monarch Tobacco Works and son of Basil Doerhoefer. The land was actually part of the same lot where the elder Doerhoefer had built his magnificent home several years earlier. All this land and both houses were sold to the Loretto High School in 1925.
