DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Dr. E.A. Kilbride Clinic is located on a corner lot at 701 Eleventh Street in Worthington, Minnesota. The appearance and massing of the building blends into the residential scale of the immediate neighborhood. The clinic is a two storey frame structure executed in a simple Italianate mode; this is characterized by rectangular massing, hipped roof, pedimented central bay, and bracketted cornice. The principal facade is symmetrical. The exterior has been altered only through the addition of a second floor exit stair and wide-lap asbestos siding over the original clapboard.

The entire interior is devoted to functions relating to medical treatment. Both floor plans consist of five rooms arranged around a central stairhall. One enters the central stairhall to the left of which is a patients' waiting room. To the right of the hall is a room which serves as an X-ray room. Immediately to the rear of these rooms are the Obstetrics room (to rear of X-ray) and the patients' examination room (to rear of the waiting room). The central room serves as an office for nurse/receptionist.

The second floor is arranged in a similar manner with the central stairhall providing access to five rooms. Directly above the X-ray room is a storage room which formerly served as a private room for patients. Above the Obstetrics room is a two-section room consisting of a surgery and sterilization area. Above the office is a lavatory. The rooms above the patients' examination and waiting rooms formerly served as wards which accommodated three or four patients per room. One of these rooms now serves as Dr. Kilbride's office.

The Dr. E.A. Kilbride Clinic exists today in essentially the same configuration as when Dr. Kilbride established it in 1927. Primarily all of the furnishings and apparatus in the clinic date to this period, however, various items were used by Dr. Kilbride's father who was also a general practitioner of medicine.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Dr. E.A. Kilbride began his practice of medicine in the Worthington area in 1926. He has continued to serve as a general practitioner and coroner since that date. In 1927 Kilbride established a general hospital and clinic at 701 11th Street in Worthington. The clinic was provided with facilities to deal with general medical situations ranging from physical exams to x-rays, obstetric care and surgery. In addition wards were provided for patient care and observation.

The clinic exists today in essentially the same state as it did when established. The majority of period medical equipment and accoutrements remain and are in use. Some of these were passed down to Dr. Kilbride from his father, also a general practitioner.

Dr. Kilbride is one of few remaining general practitioners of medicine in Worthington. He has maintained his practice at the clinic, although it is no longer used as a hospital, and plans to continue to do so until retirement. The preservation of the clinic through continued use is based on Dr. Kilbride's realization that the clinic represents an important and tangible account of developments in medical technology.

(This property should be considered to be in a tenuous situation in that it is unlikely that it will be preserved after Dr. Kilbride's occupancy if official recognition is not provided. It should therefore be considered under Exception G of the Criteria for nomination of a property to the National Register of Historic Places: "A property achieving significance within the past 50 years if it is of exceptional importance.")
