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Correction to the listing for the E. B. Williams House, part of the Kingman MRA, listed on May 14, 1986.

It has come to our attention that there is an address discrepancy for the E.B. Williams house in Kingman, Arizona. The Kingman MRA nomination lists the address correctly at 531 E. Oak, however the inventory form shows the address as 513 E. Oak. The NRIS database shows the address as 513 E. Oak, so the incorrect address must have been recorded for the property.

The Arizona State Historic Preservation Officer therefore requests that the Keeper of the National Register change the address for the E. B. Williams house to 531 E. Oak.
