On south side is an attractive residence of 1870's. A small green at this juncture of roads was scene in Revolutionary times of demonstrations and drilling. This is 1913 replica of Samuel Belcher meeting house of 1817.

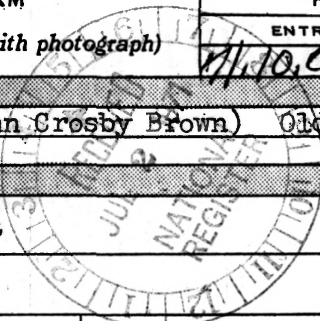

Rear chimney part of earlier house standing in early 18th century. Federal in style, remodeled extensively 1921 by Richard's son, (dormers and large north room added). Used as school and inn. Restored 1956 by present owner.

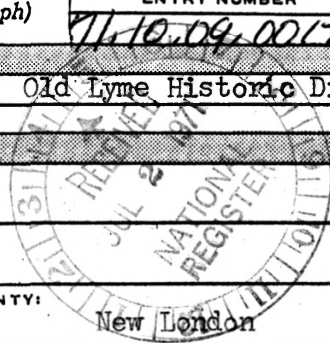

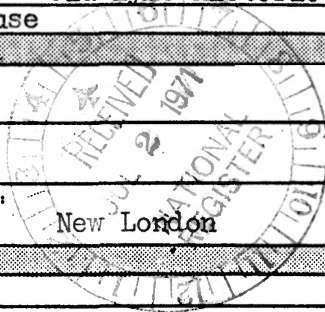

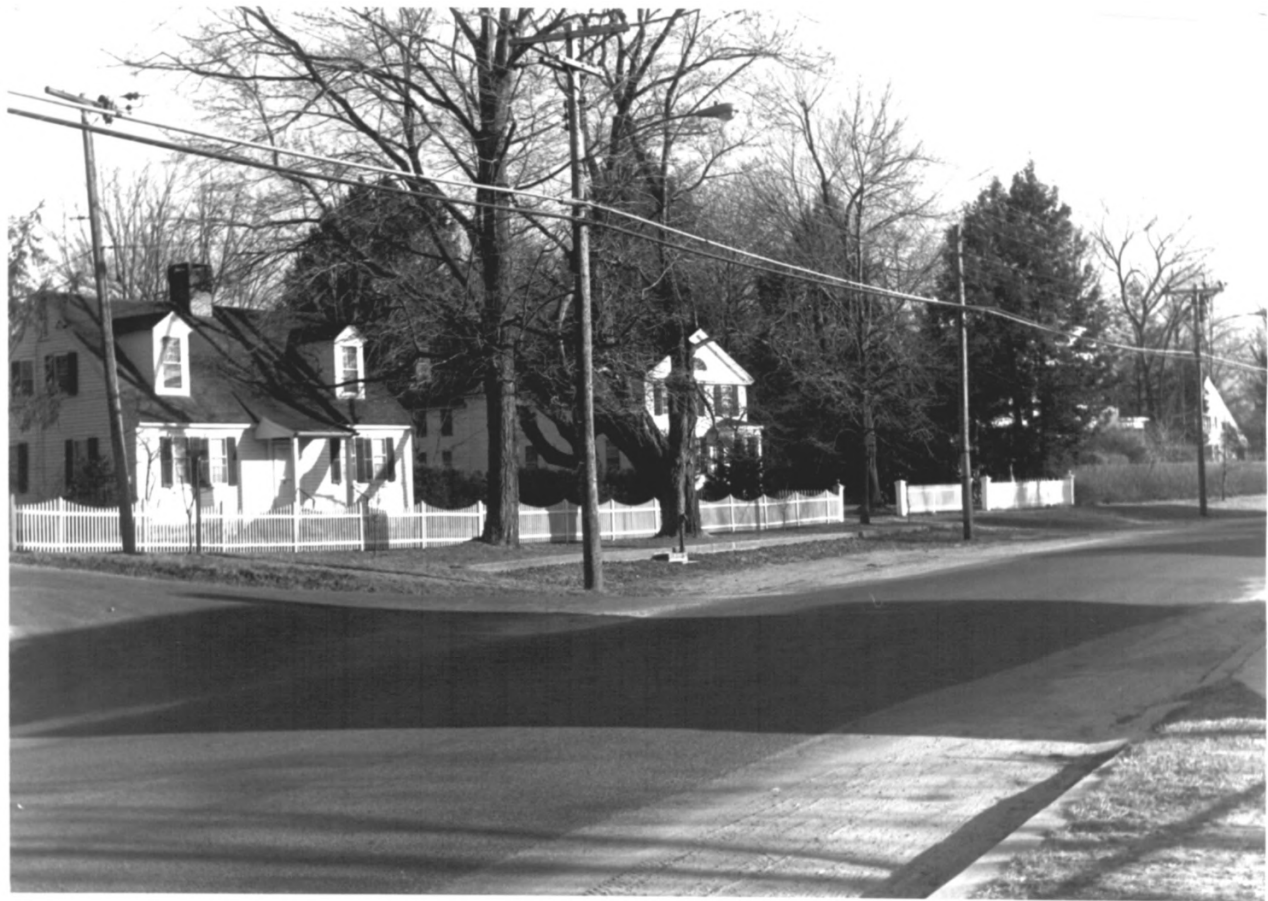

DESCRIBE VIEW, DIRECTION, ETC. View from north toward south. House faces north at start of Lyme Street. Is set well behind cast iron fencing and small green. To its west is larger house of 1870's and 1913 replica of Samuel Belcher's 1817 Meeting House, now Congregational Church. Marvin-Griffin House dates from 1820 when its main structure was shipped via Hudson River from Albany and assembled at present site.

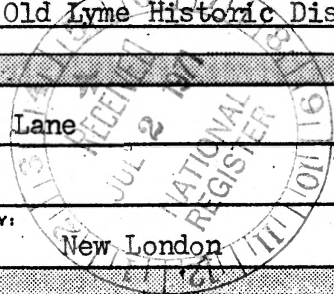

Next to Maxon House is small Greek Revival house, and beyond that a large Georgian house of 1830.

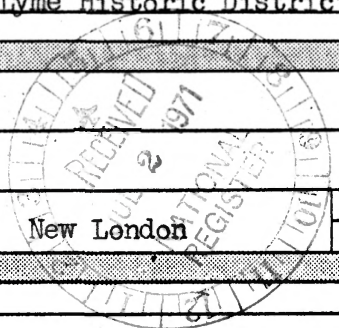

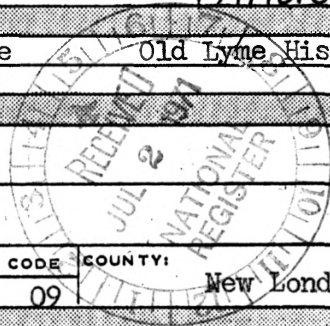

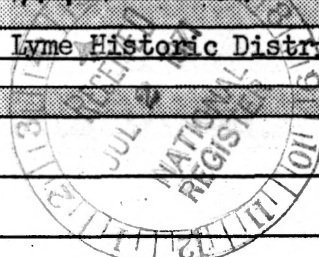
