
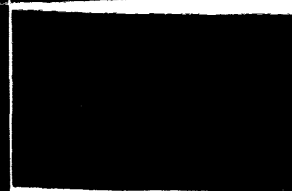

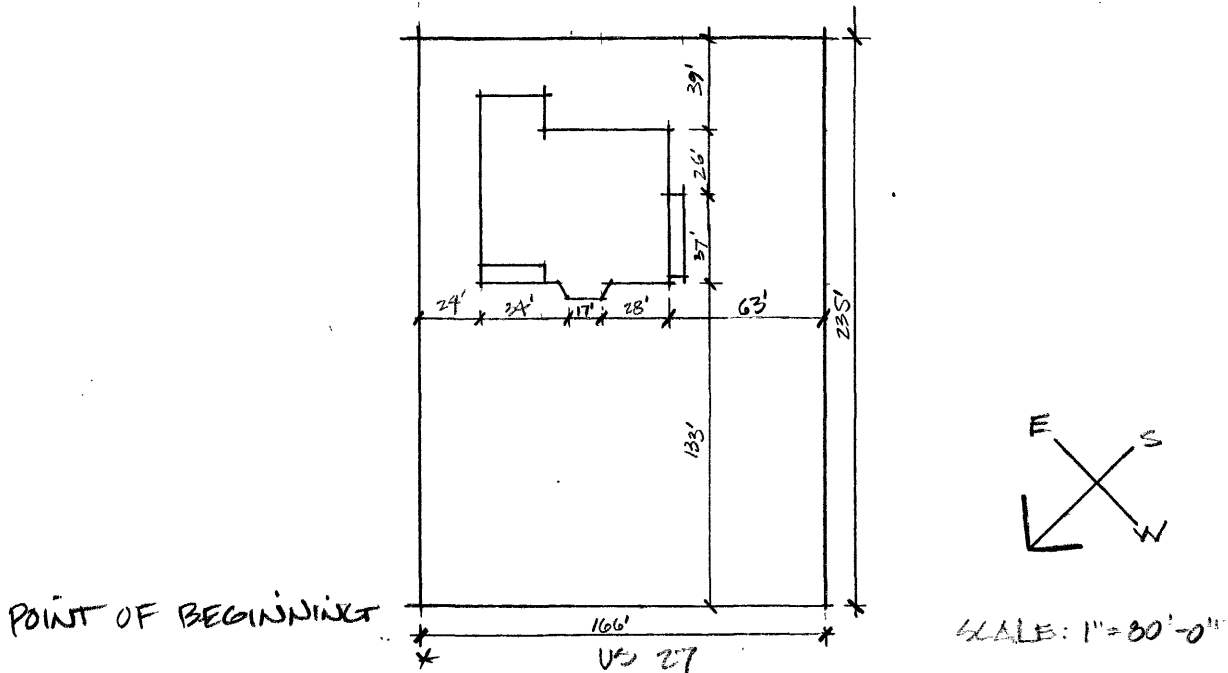

From a point in the east right of way of US 27; then southeast 235 feet to a point; then southwest 166 feet to a point; then northwest 235 feet to a point; then northeast 166 feet along the right of way of US 27 to the point of beginning.

Point of beginning is 24 feet northeast and 133 feet northwest of the northeast corner of the Gulley House.
