Construction of the City Hall began in 1846. The original architect for the building was William Gibbons, whose original plan for the seat of government was amended to allow the various Masonic bodies in the city to construct a third story on the building for their own use. The building located on one of the city's original squares, was completed in 1847 and has continued to serve as Jackson's City Hall. Soon after its completion, a ball was held in the building in June, 1847, in honor of the Mississippi Rifles, who won fame under Jefferson Davis during the Mexican War.

The City Hall was rebuilt or enlarged in 1853; municipal records not revealing exactly what happened. The architect for these renovations was J. Willis.

In 1856, the United States Government acquired an interest in City Hall for Federal Court activities upon payment of \$20,000 to the city.

During the Civil War, City Hall was used as a hospital and was one of the few buildings left standing in Jackson, which was damaged severely by Federal troops.

The building was completely remodeled and redecorated in 1963-64, under the supervision of architect Frank P. Gates.
