Beginning at A on ~~Sugar~~ Jess Ray Road, thence S with road and across driveway entrance 200 ft to B, thence W beside spring branch 300 ft to C, thence N ^{200 ft} along back of yard to D, thence E 300 ft to the beginning containing the house, cellar, and lawn. Other buildings are later. 1 1/3 acre
