### **Physical Description**

The East Buntyn Historic District is located in the city of Memphis, Shelby County, in western Tennessee. The eleven block East Buntyn Historic District is located approximately six miles east of downtown and contains a largely intact and homogenous residential building stock. As the district's name implies, the area is due east of the old railroad community of Buntyn. The boundary of the East Buntyn Historic District is formed by the rear property lines of the eastern side of Ellsworth Street on the east, the southern property lines of the last contributing houses before Southern Avenue on the south, the east side of Greer Street on the west, and the south side of Central Avenue on the north. All but Greer Street serve as major traffic arteries with an average width of eighty feet.

The district is comprised of 683 buildings, of which, 599 are contributing and 80 are noncontributing. The building stock consists of houses, duplexes, churches, garages, carports, sheds, guest houses and a greenhouse and a summerhouse. The building stock ranges from excellent to fair condition, most buildings are in good condition.

The district's internal streets are arranged in a bilateral grid with six blocks of equal size to the south of Midland and five similar blocks to the north of Midland. Holmes Circle and Overland Place represent the only departures from the district's grid plan. Overland Place is a cul-de-sac with a tree-lined median. In 1941, Holmes Street was extended north to Greer Street with the addition of Holmes Circle.

There is a marked horizontal character to the topography of East Buntyn. However, a gradual rise is detectable along a diagonal toward the southeast from Central Avenue and Greer to Ellsworth and Southern. The greatest relative incline occurs on Ellsworth between Central and Midland.

All residential streets in East Buntyn are 50 feet in width and have cast concrete curbing, gutters and three feet wide sidewalks. The streets cut directly through the gently rolling landscape resulting in terracing of varying heights on many lots. Lot sizes are generally 50 feet wide by 190 feet deep and setbacks of 40 feet predominate.

The landscaping of the East Buntyn Historic District is dominated by mature deciduous trees such as oak, maple, sweet gum and bald cypress which form green vaults over the streets creating a forest-like effect. Evergreen species of cedar, pine, native and exotic magnolia and American holly add contrasting colors and textures during the summer and winter. In addition to the shade trees, azalea, dogwood and hydrangea vividly paint the passage of the seasons.

Outbuildings in the district are mainly one car garages located on the rear of many lots at the end of the driveway. These buildings are all nearly identical gable-front buildings with the original double-hinged doors or overhead doors added at a later date.

The character of the neighborhood is defined by the almost stylistically homogenous collection of Eclectic style residential dwellings of the mid-1920s through World War II. Most of the building stock dates from circa 1925 to 1945 and displays the characteristics of the architectural forms and styles from this period. The architectural forms represented are the bungalow, the one-story Colonial Revival cottage and the Tudor cottage. Architectural styles include Craftsman, Colonial Revival, Tudor Revival, Minimal/Traditional and Ranch.

The two churches located in the district also reflect the Eclectic style of the housing stock. The 1941 East Side Cumberland Presbyterian Church at 461 S. Prescott Street is in the Tudor Revival style with stone veneer and a Tudor door with an arched stone surround and flying buttresses. The Old Sanctuary of the Buntyn Presbyterian Church is Colonial Revival and retains its integrity, however, it has been abusively altered by the 1955 addition of a new sanctuary on the south side of the building.

An inventory of all structural resources in the East Buntyn area was prepared by K. David Sample and Kim C. Isbell in 1989-1990, as part of the Memphis Survey. A first draft National Register nomination was prepared in 1990. In the summer of 1994 the survey data was field-checked and updated and a final draft was prepared by Judith Ann Johnson of the City of Memphis Division of Housing and Community Development with assistance by Tim and Jane Carroll and Jane Kowalewski.

A glossary describing the characteristics of these architectural styles, forms and their individual details are included as a continuation of this nomination. The glossary is adapted from <u>A Field Guide to American Houses</u> by Virginia and Lee McAlester, 1984.

#### Glossary Of Survey Terms

#### Bungalow

The bungalow was a generic term applied to relatively unpretentious one-story or story-and-a-half houses of 600 to 800 square feet with small bedrooms and kitchens and a combination living/dining room. This room generally featured exposed ceiling beams, a rough brick or stone fireplace and bands of windows.

#### Craftsman

The Craftsman style was a clear break from 19th-century derivative architecture that dominated American home building until circa 1910. The identifying features of the Craftsman style include a low-pitched, gable roof with wide, unenclosed eaves overhang; roof rafters usually exposed; decorative beams or braces commonly added under the gables; porches, either full- or partial-width,

with the roof supported by tapered square columns; columns frequently extend to ground level. Locally the Craftsman style retained its popularity until the mid-1930s.

Craftsman windows exhibit geometric patterns of small-pane window glazing in the upper sashes of wooden-muntin, double hung windows.

Craftsman doors exhibit multiple lights composed of a band of lights with the tracery arranged in a set of bordering square and rectangular panes. A second type of Craftsman door has an arrangement of multiple lights above a modillioned rail mounted on the spandrel, above a paneled lower area.

### **Tudor Cottage**

This style was used for a large proportion of early-20th-century suburban houses throughout the country. The style is loosely based on a variety of late Medieval English prototypes. These traditions are freely mixed but place an emphasis on steeply pitched, front-facing gables, ornamental false half-timbering and large, elaborate chimneys. Most Tudor houses have stucco, masonry or masonry-veneered walls. Decorative detailing may draw from Renaissance or modern Craftsman traditions.

Round-arched Tudor doors often are heavy board-and-batten. The doorway may display tabs of cut stone around it or flattened pointed Tudor arches are often used in doorway surrounds or on entry porches.

Prominently placed Tudor chimneys may exhibit complex masonry or stone patterns; they may exhibit multiple shafts also.

Tudor windows can be casements or double sash. Windows are frequently grouped in strings of three or more.

#### **Colonial Revival**

This was the dominate style of domestic architecture throughout the country during the first half of the twentieth century and refers to the rebirth of interest in the early English and Dutch houses of the Atlantic seaboard. Symbolic details from the precedents are often combined so eclectic mixtures are most often found instead of pure copies. Identifying features include an accentuated front door, normally with an engaged pediment supported by pilasters; a symmetrical facade; and windows with double-hung sashes, usually with multi-pane glazing. All of the Colonial Revival houses in East Buntyn are the Cape Cod type, a common form of one-story Colonial Revival house. As a form it originated in the early 18th century and continued unchanged until the 1950s. It often exhibits telescopic wings and two gable dormers.

#### **Minimal Traditional**

The Minimal/Traditional influence is the primary stylistic detailing of residential architecture following the Craftsman and Colonial Revival periods. The style was popular in the Memphis area from c. 1930 to c. 1970. These spare houses retain the form of traditional Tudor houses but lack their decoration. Roof pitches are low, eaves and rake are close, windows have little or no reveal. Brick veneered exterior surfaces were a common treatment. Often there is a large chimney and one front-facing gable, both echoing Tudor influences.

#### Ranch

This style originated in California in the mid-1930s and is loosely based on Spanish Colonial precedents of the American southwest. The form is dominated by asymmetrical one-story shapes with low-pitched hip roofs with a moderate to wide eaves overhang. Both wood and brick wall cladding are used, as well as modest bits of Spanish or English Colonial detailing.

#### INVENTORY

Contributing resources (C) add to the historic architectural qualities and historic associations for which the property is significant. Contributing resources were present during the period of significance and retain integrity. Noncontributing resources (NC) do not add to the historic architectural qualities or associations of the district because they were not present during the period of significance or they have lost integrity due to alterations.

#### Statement of Significance

The East Buntyn Historic District is being nominated under criterion C for its significance as a cohesive and largely intact collection of 20th century residential architecture embodying the range and diversity of housing prototypes that emerged during the period between 1920 and 1945.

The origins of the district are traced directly to the plantation of Geraldus Buntyn (1791-1865), a veteran of the War of 1812 and an important figure in the development of Memphis and Shelby County. Buntyn, born in North Carolina, was awarded a quarter section land grant in Shelby County for his service to the nation in the War of 1812. The 160-acre grant was bordered on the north by what is now Central Avenue and on the south by what is now Southern Avenue. The western boundary was present day Buntyn Avenue and the eastern boundary was the old Raleigh and Hernando Stage Road, now known as Highland Avenue. After acquiring 520 additional acres, Buntyn established a cotton plantation and by 1835 he had built a large Greek Revival house which stood near present day Goodwyn Road until it burned in 1910.

In 1838, the Memphis and LaGrange railroad reached Buntyn's Plantation, but due to an economic downturn construction of the railroad was not continued beyond Buntyn until 1840. Ante-bellum Buntyn, Tennessee, had a general store, a train stop, and several churches.

Geraldus Buntyn was said to have been overcome with grief at the Confederates' loss of the Civil War; he died in 1865, leaving his estate to his wife, Ann Eliza Buntyn. Three years later, in 1868, Ann Eliza died having arranged for subdivision of the Buntyn property (including the area currently comprising the East Buntyn Historic District) following her death. Unnamed developers registered the Buntyn Subdivision with the Shelby County tax offices in 1868.

The original Buntyn Subdivision extended from Buntyn Avenue on the west, Central Avenue on the north, Raleigh-Hernando Road (now Highland Avenue) on the east, and White's Station-Fort Pickering Road (now Southern Avenue) was the southern boundary with Midland Avenue as an east/west bisector. The current East Buntyn area east of Greer Street was divided into lots of ten acres each. There is no record that any development occurred in the area prior to its 1911 re-subdivision.

The Greek Revival home built by Geraldus Buntyn had a number of owners from 1868 until 1905 when it was purchased by the Memphis Country Club. In 1910, the house was destroyed by fire. Memphis Country Club rebuilt and continues its operation at the same location.

In 1911, during a period of great economic growth and eastward expansion of the city limits, the developers, Commonwealth Realty and Emest R. Parham Real Estate Company, re-subdivided the eastern part of the Buntyn Subdivision into the Country Club Subdivision. The development of the Country Club

Subdivision coincided with the opening of the Normal School on Patterson Avenue (now the University of Memphis) and the rebuilding of the Memphis Country Club, two obvious selling points to the new home buyer.

Bounded on the east by the new Normal School, on the south by the Southern Railroad, on the west by the exclusive Memphis Country Club, and on the north by estate properties, the development was marketed as a "restricted residence subdivision," suggesting that this community was protected from the commercial, industrial, and lower-income residential development that had long been considered urban problems.

As part of the 1911 subdivision, the developers added the north/south Alexander, Prescott, Reese, and Peachtree (now Ellsworth) Streets to the grid. Although the grid plan of the Country Club Subdivision reflected a pattern inherited from the earlier tradition of the streetcar suburb, the wide streets of the subdivision suggest that the automobile had supplanted the streetcar as the primary mode of transportation. The increasing reliance on the automobile had many effects on residential planning including mandatory garages, paved roads and cement curbs and gutters. Though the first house in the Country Club Place Subdivision was built in 1919, large scale development did not get off the ground until the City had connected sewer lines in the early 1920s and had made final plans to annex Buntyn in 1929.

From 1926 to 1929 the area experienced its greatest spurt of construction activity. The concentration of the Eclectic movement Craftsman and Revival styles found in East Buntyn attests to the rapid development that occurred during this three-year period, which resulted in a relatively homogenous neighborhood. The Eclectic architecture movement began quietly in the last decades of the nineteenth century and stressed relatively pure copies of the architectural traditions of different European countries and their New World colonies. This early emphasis on period styles was almost overwhelmed by the first wave of architectural modernism, the Craftsman style, during the first two decades of the twentieth century. Although World War I brought an abrupt end to this first phase of the Modern movement nationally, locally the Craftsman bungalow remained an immensely popular style with builders and consumers until the mid-1930s.

Beginning in the 1920s, fashions in domestic architecture shifted toward period or Revival styles such as Colonial, Dutch Colonial, Neoclassical and Tudor Revival. Building technology advanced to allow a thin veneer of stone or brick to be added to a traditional balloon frame house and soon modest cottages, such as those in East Buntyn, began to mimic the masonry facades of Old World landmarks or the masonry construction Colonial homes of the Eastern seaboard.

Unlike the diverse housing stock of the Hein Park Historic District (NR 11-16-88), which is comprised of very expensive homes interspersed with a variety of more modest ones, the homes in the East Buntyn historic district are more uniform in price and style. While Hein Park represented a socially diverse development, East Buntyn represented social and economic homogeneity to the families who invested in

the suburban way of life hoping to find both individual freedom and social stability at a time when America was becoming more restrictive and racially exclusive.

Development in the area slowed after the fall of 1929 and by the spring of 1933, 15 million people were out of work and there were 1000 home foreclosures a week. The housing industry was particularly hard hit so Franklin Roosevelt's New Deal government made an effort to rebuild it. The landmark National Housing Act of 1934 established, among other things, the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) to stimulate the moderate cost private-housing market by insuring low-interest, long-term mortgages with a \$20,000 ceiling. At first only expensive houses were insured, but by 1938 most loans were for moderate housing costing between \$6,000 and \$8,000.

These FHA loans were probably the stimulus for the final stage of development in the subdivision in the middle 1930s to the early 1940s. Construction of new homes resumed on the remaining vacant lots in the district and included the creation of Holmes Circle in 1941. Homes constructed after 1939 in East Buntyn, especially on Central Avenue, reflect a continued local preference for the Colonial Revival style. The undying local popularity of this style can be somewhat attributed to a nationally known Memphis architect, J. Frayser Smith, who authored a very influential book about Southern Colonial architecture called White Pillars.

By 1945, 92 percent of the area had been developed. The neighborhood has continued to experience piecemeal development from 1945 to the present. From 1965 to 1975, the neighborhood experienced a number of changes. With the aging of the resident population, there was a gradual decline in the repair of the building stock. The exodus of a number of the original inhabitants and the general flight of people to the newer suburbs was a citywide, indeed a national, phenomenon that also contributed to the decline of the neighborhood.

During the period from 1965 to 1975, the neighborhood remained viable as transient housing for students at Memphis State University. The result is that many of the single-family homes were divided into either duplexes or apartment units.

As the 1970s came to a close, the East Buntyn Historic District experienced a phenomenon common to other areas of the city. Young couples moved into the neighborhoods from which their parents had fled. By 1980, the median age of the neighborhood resident had declined from 55 in 1970 to 38.6. The infusion of new people eager to restore the neighborhood's homes to their former charm has contributed to the stability of a unique collection of homes in the Memphis area.

In addition to East Buntyn, Memphis contains two other areas that contain large numbers of Eclectic Style resources. The Cooper-Young Historic District (NR 6/22/89) and Evergreen Historic District (NR 1/11/85) share an affinity with East Buntyn in terms of 1920-1940s housing styles. However, both of those districts

developed from circa 1900 to 1930 and they exhibit an older and more varied housing stock than does the East Buntyn neighborhood with solely Eclectic style houses.

The East Buntyn district is an excellent local example of an Eclectic style suburban residential community of the 1920-1940s, a time of major technological improvements and increased reliance on the automobile. It was developed at a time when the critical problems of the American housing system such as booms and collapses of the real estate market and a tripling of the mortgage rate were redressed with personalized design and uniform planning in residential communities.

From the depths of the Great Depression came the beginning of a new wave of Modernism in architecture that was responsible for the final two historic building styles found in East Buntyn, the Minimal Traditional style and the Ranch style. Although these Modernistic styles remained rare and savant garde locally in the years before World War II, their stylistic descendants would come to dominate the domestic housing market in the decades immediately following World War II. It is the diversity, yet homogeneity of the Eclectic styles and types located here that makes the East Buntyn historic district important and worth preserving.
