DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The former LaPorte Town Hall and Fire Station contains three building phases. The first, in 1876, created a two-story brick structure, 36' x 58', with a gable roof and metal false front. Two round-arched double door entrances with three-tier brick hoods in the front mark the fire station. On the second, town hall, level, are segmental arched windows with 4/4 lights and brick hoods. A side entrance at this level, reached by wooden stairs, displays a similar treatment.

The second phase, in 1911, added a two-story brick jail, 16' x 16', to the north side of the firehouse. Window and door treatment were copied from the main structure, and a brick cornice was added below the flat roof. In 1950, a one-story addition, 36' x 24', was made to the rear of the fire station. It is made of concrete block, with a metal shed roof, and is used for equipment storage. Also in 1950, the originally round-arched fire station doors were enlarged and squared to accommodate new (and presumably larger) engines. These doorways have within the past year been restored, with great care and fine workmanship, to their original 1876 form.

The original interior arrangement on the second floor is not known, but, given the city's small population (around 1200) in the mid-1870's, there probably were only one or two rooms. This floor housed the town office(s) from 1876 until the 1930's, when it was rented to the LaPorte Community Schools for classroom and band rehearsal space. It is now one large room, with no partitions. The ground floor was the fire station from its construction until 1968. The date of the removal of the jail to other quarters is not known.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This structure is locally significant as LaPorte City's first town hall and fire station, erected five years after the town was organized and the first officials (a mayor and a clerk) were elected. City offices remained here into the 1930's (they are now in the library), perhaps because the population of this farming community, around 1200 in the 1870's, remained relatively small (today there are about 2200 people in the town). Then the government office space was rented to the town high school, which used it as a classroom facility until 1974. A new fire station was built in 1968, and the ground floor of the old structure converted into a local history and agricultural museum. The museum has since expanded to include the whole building and the old jail, as a result of community bicentennial activities. Thus the structure still acts as a center of local interest, although in ways different from its original use.
