

Description

The barn at the Pence-Carmichael Farm is a two story, wood frame livestock barn with a metal gable roof, exterior walls sheathed in weatherboard, and a foundation composed of stone piers. It features an unusual plan - transverse crib with a cross gable drive and a side shed addition -- and such other unusual features as double-leaf lattice doors at the three cattle entrances (two in the walls of the barn itself and another in the attached side shed) and crib doors inside which feature diagonal wood braces within a rectangular frame.

The later root cellar is a single story, stone building with a rectangular plan which is covered by a metal gable roof. It is supported upon a continuous, cast concrete foundation and is relieved by a single-leaf western entry and two fixed windows, one on the northern elevation and one on the eastern elevation.

Significance

Both the livestock barn and the root cellar at the Pence-Carmichael Farm are outstanding examples of their particular type. The barn is one of the best extant examples of an unusual plan. Virtually all of its interior stalls are intact from the date of construction; moreover, the use of lattice doors for all the livestock entrances is a design feature unseen elsewhere in the county. The root cellar is one of the few historic stone outbuildings surviving in White County, and both the best example of a gable roof root cellar and the most unaltered overall.

Beginning at the southwest corner of the barn (located 700 feet north of County Road 168 and 3,100 feet east of County Road 26), proceed easterly along the barn's southern elevation to a point formed by its intersection with a perpendicular line running along the eastern elevation of the root cellar; thence proceed northerly along said line to a point formed by its intersection with a perpendicular line running along the root cellar's northern elevation; thence proceed westerly along said line to a point formed by its intersection with a perpendicular line running along the western elevation of the barn; thence proceed southerly along said line to the point of beginning.

Reviewer's Comments

The boundaries of this property are presently located along building lines. A resource listed in the National Register should include all features of the property which contribute to its significance. In almost all cases this includes its historic setting. Page 77 of National Register Bulletin 16, <u>Guidelines for Completing National Register of Historic Places Forms</u>, states that "the boundaries of buildings should include the land surrounding the building, unless the lot occupied by the building contains no surrounding land as in the central business district of most cities."

Please revise the boundaries to include the property historically associated with the resource. If a portion of the original setting has lost its integrity, please explain.

In Section 3, the barn should be counted as a building, rather than a structure, since it was intended to provide shelter.

Beginning at the point formed by the intersection of a line running parallel to the barn's western elevation and located 25 feet to the west thereof with a perpendicular line running parallel to the barn's southern elevation and located 25 feet to the south thereof (located 700 feet north of County Road 168 and 3,100 feet east of County Road 26), proceed easterly along said line for a distance of approximately 400 feet to a point formed by its intersection with a perpendicular line running parallel to the eastern elevation of the root cellar; thence proceed northerly for a distance of approximately 400 feet along said line to a point formed by its intersection with a perpendicular line running parallel to the northern elevation of the root cellar; thence proceed westerly along said line for a distance of approximately 400 feet to a point formed by its intersection with a perpendicular line running parallel to the western elevation of the barn; thence proceed southerly along said line for a distance of approximately 400 feet to the point of beginning.

Boundary Justification:

This resource was constructed as part of a larger farmstead that has lost its integrity as such; thus, this boundary includes all the property known to be historically associated with this resource.
